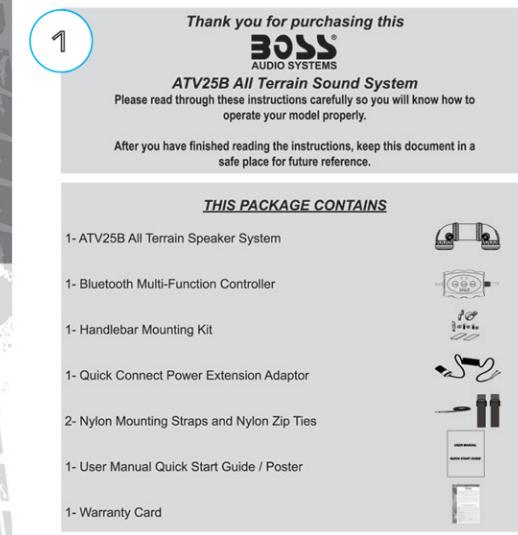

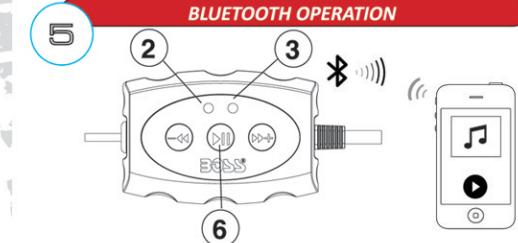

PAIRING & DISCOVERING A NEW BLUETOOTH CONNECTION

- 1) Power on the **ATV25B** by pressing and holding down the **Play/Pause** multifunction button for 3 seconds, the **2** blue and **3** red LEDs will start to alternately flash, signalling that the **ATV25B** is now ready for Bluetooth pairing.

NOTE: You have 2 minutes before you must restart this procedure over again.

- 2) Now that the **ATV25B** is in pairing mode:

ANDROID users:

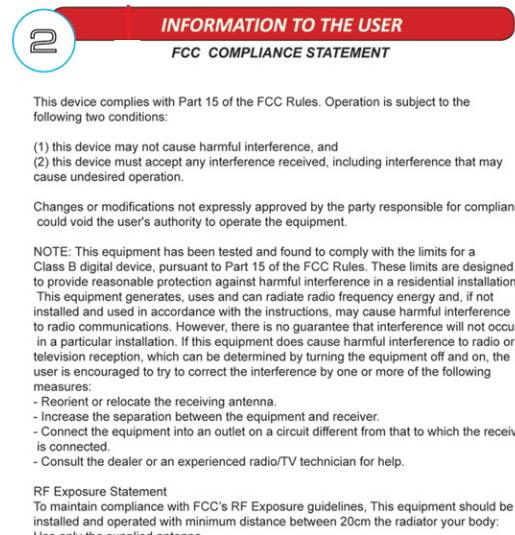
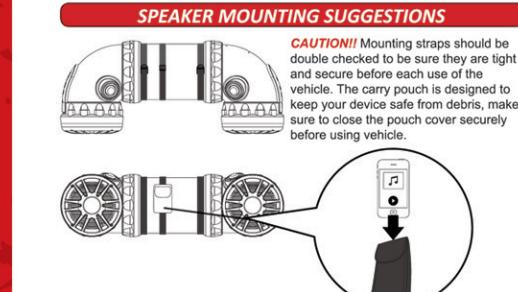
- a. Go into the **Settings Menu** of your device
- b. Enter the **Bluetooth Menu**
- c. **TURN ON Bluetooth** and press **SCAN**
- d. "**BOSS AUDIO**" will now be displayed under **AVAILABLE DEVICES**
- e. If prompted, enter passcode: "0000"

iOS users:

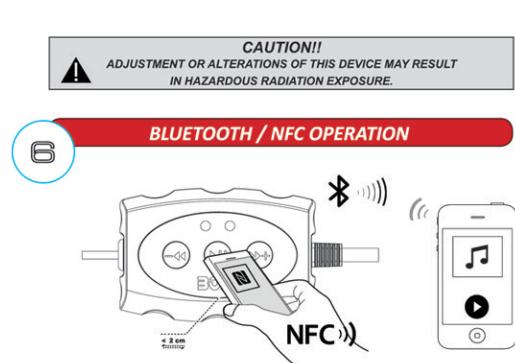
- a. Go into the **Settings Menu** of your **iOS** device
 - b. Enter the **Bluetooth Menu**
 - c. **TURN ON Bluetooth**
 - d. "**BOSS AUDIO**" will now be displayed
 - e. If prompted, enter passcode: "0000"
- 3) If the **ATV25B** is not seen, repeat the above steps to refresh the "Device List"
- 4) When the connection is successful, you are now ready to stream music from your favorite media player to the **ATV25B**



When replacing the fuse, be sure to only use a fuse of the rating specified on this product. To avoid short-circuiting, cover any disconnected leads with insulating tape. It is especially important to insulate any unused wires, which if left uncovered may cause a short circuit. When connecting other devices to this product, refer to the manual for the product to be connected. The black cable is ground, make sure to connect the ground wire first. Ensure that the ground wire is properly connected to metal parts of the vehicles body frame or direct to the battery if your vehicle does not have a grounded chassis frame. The ground wire of this units power amp and a second powered system must be connected to the frame separately with different screws. If the screw for the ground wire loosens or falls out, it could result in fire or malfunction.

RECONNECTION

- 1) Power on the **ATV25B** and your last paired device Bluetooth.

- 2) The unit will now automatically reconnect.

- 3) If your device was previously paired with the **ATV25B**, but it wasn't the last paired device:

- a. Ensure no other devices are currently paired
- b. Enter the **Bluetooth Menu** on your device being paired
- c. "**BOSS AUDIO**" will display under **AVAILABLE DEVICES**
- d. Choose the "**BOSS AUDIO**" to reconnect

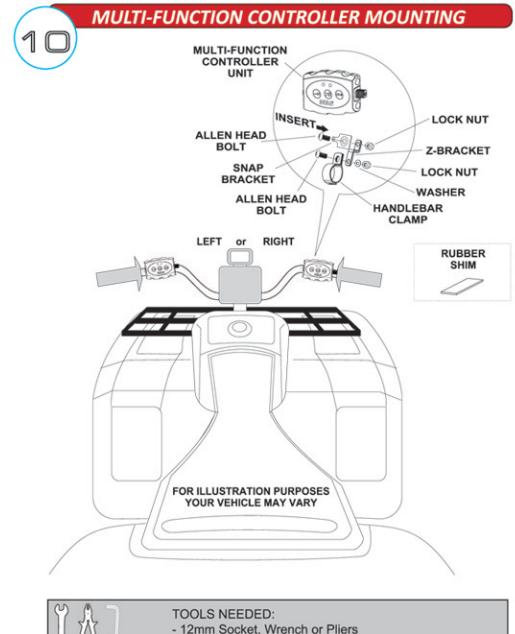
- 4) If the device is out of range from the **ATV25B**, it will disconnect automatically:

- a. To reconnect once device is back in range, press the **Play/Pause** button once
- b. The **ATV25B** will now reconnect to the device

NFC SIMPLE PAIR

NFC enabled devices tap within 1/2" of the **BOSS** logo, you will hear a confirmation tone, your device will now automatically be paired without any further procedures, some **NFC** devices will require several attempts to successfully pair

TIPS: To avoid battery exhaustion, be sure to occasionally run the vehicles engine while using this product. Using this product without running the engine can drain the battery.



MULTIFUNCTION CONTROLLER BLUETOOTH OPERATION

- 1) Press the **PLAY/PAUSE** once to start playing music or press the **PLAY** button from your device touch screen

- 2) To skip songs or advance, press the **NEXT TRACK** button

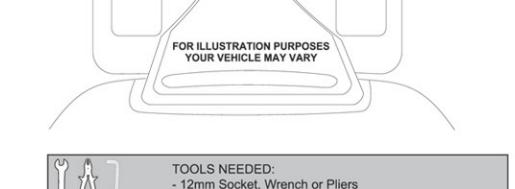
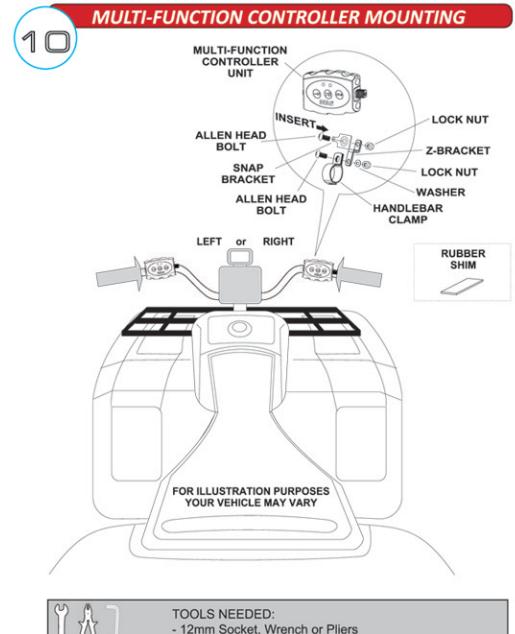
- 3) To select the previous song, press the **PREVIOUS TRACK** button

VOLUME CONTROL

- 4) To raise the volume **Press and Hold** the **VOL +** button 2 ~ 3 seconds

- 5) To lower the volume **Press and Hold** the **VOL -** button 2 ~ 3 seconds

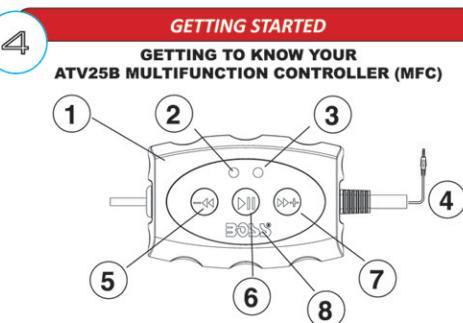
TIPS: Make sure your device Bluetooth volume is set at 75% level before stowing in to the carry pouch

1 MFC - MULTIFUNCTION CONTROLLER

2 BLUETOOTH INDICATOR LED - BLUE COLOR

3 POWER INDICATOR LED - RED COLOR

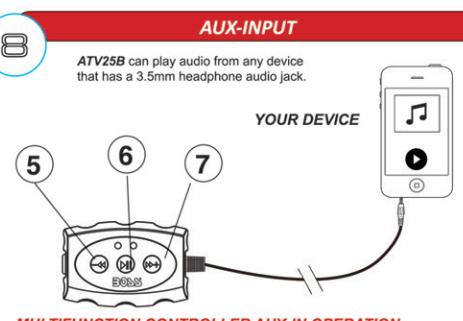
4 3.5mm AUX-INPUT

5 PREVIOUS TRACK / Press and hold for VOL -

6 PLAY/PAUSE / Press and hold for POWER ON

7 NEXT TRACK / Press and hold for VOL +

8 NFC SIMPLE PAIR LOCATION



MULTIFUNCTION CONTROLLER AUX-IN OPERATION

- 1) Power on the **ATV25B** by pressing and holding down the **PLAY/PAUSE** multifunction button for 3 seconds

- 2) Disconnect any paired **Bluetooth** device by turning off **Bluetooth** in your devices **Settings Menu**

- 3) Connect the integrated 3.5mm **AUX-IN** cable located on right side of the MFC to your devices headphone jack

- 4) Route the wire back to **ATV25B**, strap and secure your device in the supplied soft carry pouch

VOLUME CONTROL

- 5) To raise the volume **Press and Hold** the **VOL +** button 2 ~ 3 seconds

- 6) To lower the volume **Press and Hold** the **VOL -** button 2 ~ 3 seconds

TIPS: Make sure your device headphone volume is set at 75% level before stowing in to the carry pouch
