2.Installation instructions

SIM/SAM card : Shutdown the machine, open the battery cover, take out battery, put SIM/SAM card chip face down and insert into the corresponding identification card slot.

Battery : Open the battery cover, insert the battery plug into the battery socket. Put the battery into the battery tank, place the protruding part towards the head to close the battery cover conveniently.

Battery cover : Insert the upper end of the battery cover into the machine, and then fasten the clasp downward.

Note : 1. Before installing the battery, please check the battery appearance without any damage.
2. If the battery cover is held up, please turn the battery to install.


3. Product operation

Power on : Long press the power button for 3 seconds, the backlight of the screen lights up, and the terminal is activated.


Close : Long press the power button for 3 seconds, the POS machine enters the shutdown process.

Charging : After installing the battery and closing the battery cover, connect the Micro-USB interface of POS device. Connect the adapter at one end and start charging after turning on the power.

4.Matters needing attention
