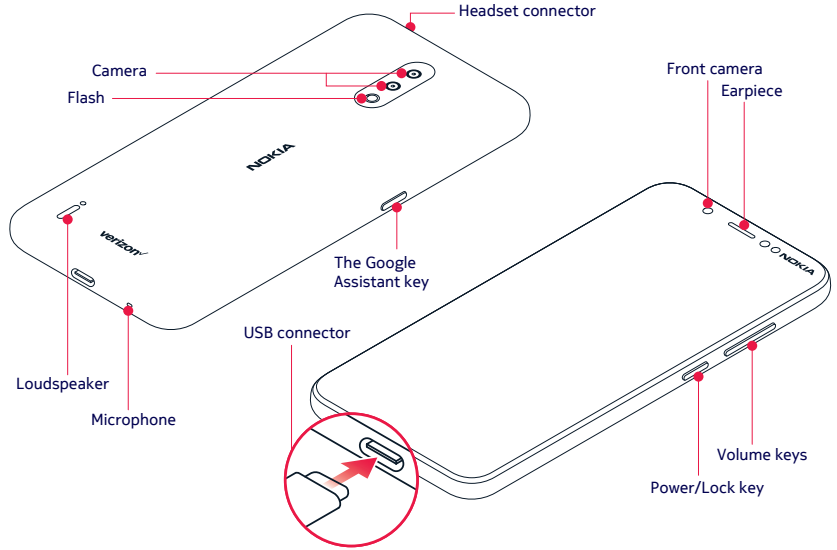

Setting up your phone

Your phone already has a SIM card installed

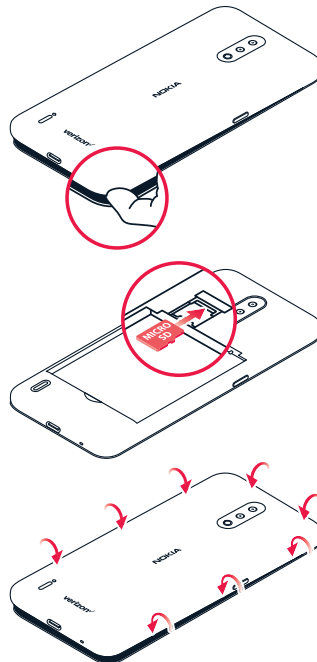
Optional: Insert the microSD card

1. Place your fingernail in the seam between the back cover and the display, and pop the cover off the phone.
2. Slide the microSD card into the microSD card slot with the gold contacts facing down.
3. Insert the battery, making sure the gold contacts line up. Press down gently to secure.
4. Replace the cover over the back of the phone, and then press down along the edges to secure.

Note: The microSD card is sold separately.

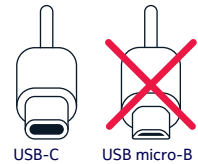
Use only compatible memory cards approved for use with this device. Incompatible cards may damage the card and the device and corrupt data stored on the card.

Important: Do not remove the memory card when an app is using it. Doing so may damage the memory card and the device and corrupt data stored on the card.



Charging your phone

Plug a compatible charger into a wall outlet, and connect the cable to your phone. Your phone supports the USB-C cable.



If the battery is completely discharged, it may take several minutes before the charging indicator is displayed.

To switch your phone on, press and hold the power key until the phone vibrates. The phone guides you through the setup.

If you have backed up your old phone's contents to your Google account, you can copy them to your new phone: tap **Settings > Accounts > Add account > Google**, enter your account details, and select which data you want to restore on your new phone. The content sync starts automatically once your phone is connected to the internet.

To lock the phone, press the Power/Lock key. To unlock, press the key again and enter your credentials, if asked.
