
1. What's in the box

X05-1 Bluetooth speaker, USB charging cable, Line in cable, user manual




2. Charging the speaker

To charge your speaker connect the USB charging cable to the micro USB port on the speaker and connect the other end to power. Whilst charging the LED indicator will turn red. When fully charged the red LED indicator will turn off. The speaker will take 3 hours to fully charge.



3. Low battery indicator


When the charge on the speaker is becomes low, the red LED will flash twice every four seconds and the speaker will beep.



4. Turning the speaker on/off

To turn the speaker on, press the power button once. The speaker will beep and the blue and red LEDs will flash.


To turn the speaker off, press the power button once. The speaker will beep and the blue LED will turn on and then turn off.



5. Play via Bluetooth

Turn the speaker on. Locate the speaker in your device's Bluetooth settings and connect. If the Bluetooth device asks for a connection code use 0000 or 1234. Once connected the speaker will beep and blue LED will flash.

If you already have a Bluetooth connection, the speaker will automatically search for it and connect when you turn the speaker on.




6. Play via line in cable

Turn the speaker on. Connect the line in cable to the speaker and to audio source. Please note only the volume controls work when connected via line in, you cannot skip or pause tracks.



7. Guide to the controls



V-((Press once to skip to the previous track


Press and hold to reduce the volume

V+>> Press once to skip to the next track

Press and hold to increase the volume

8. Answering a phone call

To answer a phone call press the **NH** button. The music will automatically pause. Press the **NH** button again to end the phone call. The music will automatically restart.
