  TWS allows you to sync 2 BLAST. Make sure neither BLAST are connected to any device. Power on both and make sure they are in Bluetooth® mode. Double click 

  An audio indicator will confirm the speakers have connected with each other. Enable Bluetooth® on the device you want to connect the speaker to and connect your device to IJOY BLAST. Double click
