The Device, FCC ID: 2AJRJ-CM105 is seeking FCC authorization as a modular transmitter. The EUT meets the requirement for modular approval as detailed in FCC section 15.212. Compliance to each of the requirements is described below:

The modular transmitter must have its own power supply regulator.	The EUT has its own voltage regulation circuitry. Please see schematics of the module.	
The module must contain a permanently attached antenna, or contain a unique antenna connector, and be marketed and operated only with specific antenna(s), per §§ 15.203, 15.204(b), 15.204(c), 15.212(a), 2.929(b);	The EUT contain a unique antenna connector as RP-SMA type. So the EUT meets the FCC antenna requirements.	
The module must demonstrate compliance in a stand-alone configuration;	The EUT was tested in a stand-alone configuration.	
The module must be labeled with its permanently affixed FCC ID label, or use an electronic display (see KDB Publication 784748);	The EUT is labeled with its own FCC ID number	
The module must comply with all specific rules applicable to the transmitter, including all the conditions provided in the integration instructions by the grantee;	The EUT is complaint with all applicable FCC rules.	
The module must comply with RF exposure requirements	The EUT fully complies with RF exposure requirements.
