# **3 Quick Start Guide**

## **3.1 Key Functions**

#### Description:

Power button Press to sleep/wake up, hold down to startup and sl		
Volume+ (up)	Increase the volume.	
Volume - (down)	Decrease the volume.	
HOME button (home)	Return to home screen.	
Back button (back)	Return to previous screen.	
Open windows button	Display recently browsed history.	

## 3.2 Startup and Shutdown

#### Startup

Hold POWER key for three seconds to start the tablet.

#### Shutdown

- 1) Hold the POWER key, it will open shutdown window.
- Shutdown window contains Mute Mode, Airplane Mode, Reboot Mode, and Shutdown options.

## 3.3 Apps

To open an app, simply touch it once.

To close an app, click on the square button on bottom of the screen, and slide the apps you want closed to the left.

To change the location of an app on the home screen, hold down the app and slide it to its destination.

To create a folder, slide an app onto another app you wish to group it with. You can then name the folder by opening the folder and clicking on "unnamed folder."

To delete an app, simply hold your finger on the app until an X appears on the screer, and slide the app to the X.

To view all apps, select the "All Apps Icon," shown below.




To download apps that did not come installed on your tablet, you can visit the Google Play store located on your home screen.

#### Password/Pin Code

To set a PIN number or Password lock on the tablet, open the Settings application, click on "Safety," then "Screen Lock," and then choose whichever method you prefer.

## 3.4 Home Page

When in the main interface as below (Picture 3.2), long press the blank area and it will popup windows to set Wallpaper, Folder, Widgets, and Shortcut.




### Change the wallpaper of desktop

# 4.1 Wireless and Internet

- Choose the Wi-Fi you want to connect to. If it has a password, the password window will pop up; enter the password, and click connect.



## 4.4 Airplane Mode

When in Airplane Mode, the tablet cannot send or receive data. To enable or disable Airplane Mode, simply swipe down from the upper right corner of the screen and pull down the menu that opens on the top of the screen. Then, click on Airplane Mode.

## 4.5 Display

### 1. Adjust the screen brightness

- 1) Click Settings app.
- 2) Click "Display," and then choose "Brightness."
- 3) Drag the indicator to adjust the brightness, as shown in Picture 4.5.

#### 3. Auto-Rotation

Auto-Rotation is when the tablet automatically switches from a vertical view to a horizontal view when turned sideways. To toggle this option on and off, simply swipe down from the upper right corner of the screen to pull down the menu that opens on the top of the screen, and select "Auto-Rotate."

Connect to WIFI and login to your google account, and choose "Backup My Data." The system will backup your data into the Google server.



## 5.5 FM Radio

Click the FM Radio icon, to enter into the FM radio interface:
