DO'S & DONT'S



Watch your pet, talk to them remotely, record videos and get notifications about your pet's activity.



Share access to your Petcube Bites with friends, family or anyone within the Petcube community.



Play with your pet using a safe built-in laser toy. Helps your animal stay fit and entertained.

- ✘ Don't drop, hit, or shake your Petcube Play.
- ✘ Do not use the laser to guide an animal in any direction that may cause harm to the pet, which includes windows, stoves, etc. Beware, pointing the laser at fragile objects may encourage your pet to damage or break them.
- ✘ Don't scratch or otherwise damage the front glass.
- ✘ Petcube Play should not be used by minors without supervision from an adult.
- ✘ Don't have prolonged direct eye contact with the laser beam.
- ✘ Protect the power cord from being walked on, pinched, or chewed on by pets.
- ✘ Don't use the Petcube Play laser with other optics. Sometimes, glasses and watches have magnifying properties.
- ✘ To avoid overheating, don't leave your Petcube Play in direct sunlight.
- ✘ Don't point the laser at people.
- ✘ Don't expose Petcube Play to liquid, moisture, dust, excessive heat, or open flames.

FCC STATEMENT
