

**Step 3:** Enter your WiFi password for your phone and click "Confirm" to enter the page of the search device.




Step 4: Enter the device page, then complete the configuration

How to use Amazon Echo to control your Smart devices?


**Step 1:** Open the" Amazon Alexa" APP, then find the "Skills "button on the menu. Press it.






Step 2: Search the" Smart life" and choose the first one, then Enable it.
