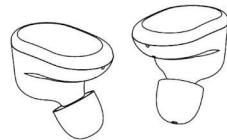

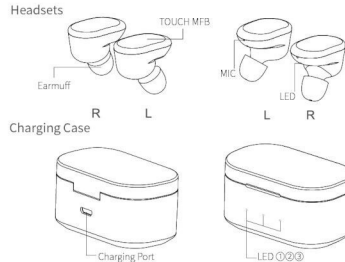

## Operation Instructions

### Charging

1. Use DC5V charger or a computer USB Jack to charge the charging case. The LED ② is red as be charging, and turn to be blue when fully charged.
2. Place the headsets into the charging case correctly, the charging case LED ①&③ be on red when charging, the LED lights will turn to be blue then go off within 10 seconds as soon as finished charging.
3. Charge the charging case and headsets at least once every three months if long time no use.

### Booting & Shutdown

Press and hold the headset MFB for 3 seconds to boot, and the LED indicator will be blue.  
Hold down the headset MFB for 5 seconds to turn off.

### Pair Twins Headsets

A. Twins Headsets pairing: Left and Right headset will connect in stereo automatically when booted approximately the same time.

B. Mobile phone connection: The Left headset enters into pairing state after twins headsets connected, indicated by a alternating flashing red/blue LED light. Enable your phone's Bluetooth and search, select "K9" to pair and connect.

### Pair Single Headset

Switch on a single headset, it will enters into pairing mode in 5 seconds, connect from your phone by searching 'K9' in Bluetooth Settings and selecting 'Pair'.

### Music Control

Touch the Right or Left headset MFB to Pause/Play the current song.

### Incoming Call Answer

Touch the headset MFB to answer incoming calls or to end calls.  
Touch and hold the MFB for 2 seconds to reject incoming calls.

### Voice Dialing

Hold down the headset MFB for 2 seconds to activate the voice assistant, as long as your device support that.

### Volume Adjustment

Quickly double touch the Right headset MFB to turn up the volume, double touch the Left headset MFB rapidly to turn down the volume.

## Q&A for Exception Handling

Q: Why can't my headset be switched on?

A: If the headsets don't boot properly, it could be due to low power, please recharge the headsets before use.

Q: Why can't my phone find the Bluetooth headset to pair with?

A: Please make sure your phone Bluetooth is in 'device visible' mode, and the headset be in pairing mode at the same time.

Q: Why does the headset have no sound when playing music?

A: Check whether the device has successfully connected via Bluetooth to the headset. If not, please do reconnect device with the headsets properly following the steps above.

Q: How to adjust the volume when used them separately?

A: Please control the volume on your phone, because the headset can adjust the volume one-way while used singly.

## Safety Precautions

Please make sure the following instructions:

1. Keep the device out of extreme heat, humidity, corrosion.
2. Prevent the device from being strike, fall, warp, soaking etc.
3. Not allowed to dismantle the earbuds or charging case.
4. Don't overcharge the device for a long time.
4. Stop using the device immediately if it causes discomfort or pain.
