#### Precaution

- Thank you for choosing the camera. Please carefully read the manual before using, and keep it at a safe place for future reference.
- ☆ The compilation of the user manual refers to the latest information. The manual quotes captured screen displays and graphics, with the aim to introduce the digital camera through detailed and direct methods. Due to the differences of technical R&D and production batch, those captured screen displays and graphics indicated in the manual may be different from that of actual digital camera.

#### Camera Maintenance

- $\stackrel{\wedge}{\succsim}$  When the camera is in idle, please keep it in dry shady place.
- $\stackrel{\wedge}{\precsim}$  Use protective cases to avoid the scratches to lens and LCD.
- ☆ If lens is needed to be cleaned, firstly blow away the dust on the surface, then use cloth or paper suitable for optical devices to clean. Detergent could be used if necessary. Please don't use organic solvent to clean.
- $\precsim$  Please do not touch the lens by figures.

  m \sim}$  Please do not put the camera in moist or dusty place. Electricity leakage may cause fire.
- $\precsim$  Keep the camera away from drops and bumps. It may cause damage to the parts inside.

### 3. Functional keys and indicators

Keys/Indicators	Function
On/Off Key	On/Off;ModeswitchamongVideo/Photo/Playback/System Settings; To snapshot images while recording videos
OK/Shutter button	Start/Stop recording/shoot photo, Start/Stop playing video(Playback Mode), Confirmation function; In certain mode, long press the button to pop up the menu
UP	Long press to open WIFI,Page UP(Menu Settings), Page UP to view files in Playback Mode
Down	Long press to open WIFI; Page down(Menu Settings), Page down to view files in Playback Mode
Charging indicator	LED light is on when charging the camera. After finishing charging, the LED light turns off
Working indicator	When the camera is recording/shooting/LCD auto off, the LED light is on; The LED light flashes when recording videos
WIFI indicator	When open WIFI, theLED light flashes. After connecting WIFI, the LED light is on

#### 4. Charge the detachable Li-ion battery

Connect the camera to power through USB cable. When charging, the LED charging light turns on. The battery icon flashes on upper right LCD. After finishing charging, the LED charging indicator turns off. Note:

4.1 To speed up the charging, please charge the camera after power off;

4.2 Power off the camera, get the camera charged by connecting to PC. The LED charging indicator is on. After

finishing charging, the indicator turns off. Normally, it takes 2-4 hrs to finish charging.

4.3 please use the DC charger for equipment, specifications: DC5V - 2A .

#### 5. How to use memory card

The camera supports the memory card of 64 GB max. It doesn't support hot plug. A high speed memory card of above C6 is suggested to be used. A memory card must be inserted into the camera before using. After inserting the memory card, make sure to format the memory card on the camera first.

5.1 Insert the memory card as indicated by the icon into the slot until the card totally inside.

5.2 To remove the memory card, gently press the edge of the memory card until it pops out.



Note: The camera doesn't have built-in memory. A memory card must be inserted into the camera before using.

After inserting the memory card, make sure to format the memory card on the camera first.

#### 6. Power on/off

- 6.1 Power on: Keep pressing the Power key for 3s till the screen is on.
- 6.2 Power off: keep pressing the camera for 3s to power off
- 6.3 Auto off: The camera turns off after no use of the camera for a certain time (Default time is 3mins)
- 6.4 Power off by low battery: When the camera is in low battery, the battery icon Flashes. Please

charge the camera timely. The camera would turn off automatically in low battery.

#### 7. Functional Modes of the camer

Video Mode: Recording videos

Photo Mode: Shooting photos

Playback Mode: Review files in the camera

System Settings Mode: Make settings of the system

#### 8. Video Mode

Enter to settings of Video Mode:

a. Touch the settings icon on the bottom right corner of LCD

- b. Long press OK key
- c. Swipe the screen from bottom to top(Swipe vertically)

8.1 Recording video: In Video Mode, short press OK key or touch the red dot on the screen to start recording. When recording starts, the camera makes the voice prompt and starts to time the video from " **00: 00: 01**". Press OK key once again to stop recording and the camera makes voice prompt of stopping recording. The camera automatically stops recording when the memory is full.

- 8.2 Snapshot: When the camera is recording, short press On/Off key to capture the certain image. (Note: The recording continues when snapshot. The captured image can be viewed in Playback.)
- 8.3 Loop recording: In settings of Video Mode, set Loop Recording "ON" and choose Recording time (3/5/10 mins). If the time is set to be 3 mins, press OK to record, the video is automatically saved as a file after 3 mins. Then the camera continues to record next video. The recording time on LCD starts at zero. When the memory is full, the first video would be covered, and so on.
- 8.4 Motion Detection: In settings of Video Mode, set Motion Detection "ON". The camera starts recording after detecting motions and stops recording after no motion of 10s.
  Note: when choose interval video, UHDP24 resolution has no effect

#### 9. Photo Mode


Switch to Photo Mode:

- a. Touch the icon in left bottom LCD
- b. Short press On/Off key
- c. Swipe the LCD from right to left
- 9.1 To enter settings of Photo Mode:
  - a. Touch the settings icon on the bottom right corner of LCD
  - b. Long press OK key
  - c. Swipe the screen from bottom to top(Swipe vertically)
- 9.2 Photo shooting: short press the OK key or touch the red dot on the screen to shoot photos. Photos are automatically saved after shooting.
- 11.3 Burst: In settings of Photo Mode, set the burst times (3/5/10). In Photo Mode, press OK to burst. Set Burst to Single, the camera would be normal shooting mode;
- 9.4 Scenes: In Settings of Photo Mode, set the scene among Night Scene/Portrait/Light painting.When Scene is set on, burst does not work. (Note: If Light painting is chosen, it takes 10s to shoot one image);
- 9.5 Zoom: In Photo Mode, press Up/Down key to zoom in/out.

#### 10. Playback Mode

- Switch to Playback Mode:
- a. Touch the icon in left bottom LCD
- b. Short press On/Off key
- 10.1 To enter settings of Playback Mode:
  - a. Touch the settings icon on the bottom right corner of LCD
  - b. Long press OK key
  - c. Swipe the screen from bottom to top(Swipe vertically)
- 10.2 In Playback Mode, swipe the LCD from right to left/press UP or Down key to choose videos/photos to view. Press OK to start playing the video and press OK one more time to stop playing.

10.3 In Playback Mode, below window would pop up by touching the screen

#### 11. System Settings Mode

Switch to System Settings Mode:

- a. Touch the icon in left bottom LCD
- b. Short press On/Off key
- c. Swipe the LCD from up to bottom

11.1 Date/Time settings: In System Settings Mode, choose the icon of "Date/Time". Press OK ortouch the

icon to access the settings of Date/Time. Touch Up/Down icon to change thevalues of Date/Time.

Press OK or touch the check icon to save the changes.

11.2 TV: In System Settings Mode, choose TV icon, set TV "ON". Connect the camera with TVthrough

TV-USB cable. TV shows screen shows the frames of the camera; Set TV off, TV disconnects the camera.

(Note: TV-USB cable is not included in standard accessories. Touse the function, please use the TV-USB

cable equipped with the camera)

#### 12. Connect to PC

- 12.1 Power on the camera, connect the camera to PC with USB cable. After connection, the screen shows Mass Storage/ PC Camera;
- 12.2 Choose the "STORAGE", press " OK" key to connect with PC, then you can find a new disk in the" my computer", the shoot file are saved in the "Novatek" folder of the new disk, "Movie" is video file, "Photo" is picture file. you can download them to PC directly.
- 12.3 Choose the item "PC Camera", press "OK" key to connect with PC,

the camera can be used as webcam.

- 14.3 After successful connection, the camera screen would turn off to save power. Press any key to turn on the screen.

todisconnect" on the screen to disconnect.

14.5 After wifi connection, open the APP "CamKing" on mobile devices


14.6 Press buttonb **I** to change mode between Video and Photo
