Automated Pairing

- Take out two earbuds from charging case, after waiting for 4-5 seconds, two earbuds will pairing with each other automatically.
- Go onto your device and find "HT-E6" in your BT available devices.

Manual Pairing

- Press and hold the function k ey of two earbuds for 5 seconds (until the indicator light is flashing blue and red).
- Go into your device and find "HT-E6" in your BT available devices.

Note: Pairing mode should only be used on the initial pairing of a new device OR to reset the pairing between the earbuds and device.
