

### A Quick Look at Your Device



### Charging Your Speaker

Your speaker has a built-in, rechargeable lithium ion battery. To avoid damage, do not attempt to remove the battery. The full performance of the battery is only achieved after a few charging-discharging cycles. Charge the battery fully before first use. To do so, follow the steps below:

1 Connect one end of the included LISB charging cable to the charging port on your speaker Then plug the other end of the USB charging cable to the charging port on your speak. Then plug the other end of the USB charging cable into a USB port on your computer or a suitable power adapter in order to recharge the internal rechargeable battery.

NOTE: The internal battery of your speaker takes approximately two hours to charge when

2. When the battery is charging, the LED indicator light will turn red. The LED indicator light will turn off when the battery is fully charged. Unplug when charging is complet

**NOTE:** Overcharging could reduce the life of the battery. A charged battery will lose its capacity if it is not used on a regular basis.

To avoid a complete discharge of the battery, charge your speaker at least once every six

### Pairing Your Speaker with a Bluetooth Device

Your speaker can be paired with most smartphones and bluetooth devices. In order to pair your speaker with a phone, follow the steps below:

1 Press and hold the Power/Play/Pause/Answer button until your speaker nowers on Once your peaker is powered on, the LED indicator light will turn blue and blink rapidly. This indicates that your speaker is in pairing mode

- 2. Go to the Bluetooth Manager of your Bluetooth device
- 3. Search Bluetooth devices and select your speaker (most frequently listed as "Vivitar VTL60011") to start connecting.
- 4. Enter "0000" if your device asks for the PIN code.
- 5. Once paired, the LED indicator light will stop blinking and steadily shine blue. Note that anytime music is playing, the lights will slowly blink every few seconds.

### **Auxiliary Input Mode**

To use your speaker with devices that are not Bluetooth enabled, plug one end of a standard 3.5mm audio cable into the Auxiliary Port on the rear of your speaker. Plug the other end into the headphone jack on your audio device.

NOTE: If a phone or other audio source is directly plugged into your speaker through the auxiliary port, your speaker will automatically go into Auxiliary Mode in which music is played from the plugged in device.

### Using Your Speaker

Powering Your Speaker On and OFF
1. To power on your speaker, press and hold the Power/Play/Pause/Answer button until your speaker powers on. If you have already paired your speaker to your Bluetooth device, they will speaker powers on. If you have already paired your speaker to your bluetooth device, they automatically remain paired each time you power on your speaker.

2. Press and hold the Power/Play/Pause/Answer button in order to power off your speaker.

- Listening to Music

   Power/Play/Pause/Answer Button: Press to play or pause a track.

   Press and hold the "NEXT TRACK/VOLUME UP" button to advance to the next song in a
- Proces and hold the "DREVIOUS TRACK AVAILIME DOWN" button to go back to the provious
- song in a playlist.

   Quickly tap the "NEXT TRACK/VOLUME UP" to increase the volume.

   Quickly tap the "PREVIOUS TRACK/VOLUME DOWN" button to decrease the volume.

### Using the Phone Function

- Answering a Call: Quickly press the ANSWER button to answer an incoming call.
- Reject an Incoming Call: Press and hold the ANSWER button to reject an incoming call.
   Ending a Call: Quickly press the ANSWER button to end a call.

When your speaker is powered on, you can press the MODE button repeatedly to switch between light modes. There are three total light modes to choose from.

### Maintenance and Care

-Before using your speaker, inspect the ports to make sure that they are clear of dust and debris before charging or inserting an AUX cable.

-Use a soft cloth to clean your speaker. Never use any harsh chemicals or detergents. Make sure your speaker is dry before charging

When your speaker is not in use, it should be stored in a cool, dry place

Never tug or yank on either USB charging cables or AUX cables while they are connected to your speaker. Connect and disconnect these cables as carefully as possible
