

<p><b>OVERVIEW OF THE SPEAKER</b> EN</p>	<p><b>RECHARGING THE BATTERY</b> EN</p> <p>Please charge your speaker using the cable included in the box before using it for the first time or when the battery is drained.</p> <p>(USB charging cable supplied)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Plug the micro USB connector into the speaker's USB port and connect it to a USB port on your computer to charge the battery.</li> <li>2. Using another charger could cause an electric shock or damage the speaker.</li> <li>3. The indicator light turns red when the battery is charging.</li> <li>4. The battery takes between 2 hours 30 minutes and 3 hours to recharge.</li> </ol>	<p><b>CONNECTION</b> EN</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Make sure the loudspeaker is switched « OFF ».</li> <li>2. To enable BT, turn the ON / OFF switch to position B so that the indicator light flashes blue 6 times. Hold the Play / Pause button down until the indicator light flashes blue continuously. BT is then disabled.</li> <li>3. Follow the instructions for use on your mobile phone to enable Bluetooth. This can normally be done by going to the « Settings », « Connection » or « BT » menu and selecting the option to search for BT devices.</li> <li>4. The phone will detect the MBZPA156 speaker and ask you if you want to connect your phone to the loudspeaker. Select « Yes » or « Confirm » to enable this action.</li> <li>5. Enter the password or PIN code 0000, then select « Yes » or « Confirm ». (Important note: If the connection is successful, the indicator light will flash blue). If the connection has failed, the blue light will stay on permanently.</li> </ol>	<p><b>HOW TO USE</b> EN</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• TF / BT mode, press the « next » button to play the next song, hold it down to increase the volume. Doesn't work in AUX mode.</li> <li>• TF / BT mode, press the « previous » button to play the song before, hold it down to reduce the volume. Doesn't work in AUX mode.</li> <li>• TF mode, press the Play / Pause button to Play / Pause. BT mode, press the Play / Pause button to Play / Pause / Answer / End Call / Cancel call / Connect. BT mode, double-click to redial the last number, hold down for 2 seconds to reject call. TF / AUX mode, hold the button down to enable TF mode in AUX mode and vice versa.</li> </ul>	<p><b>INDICATOR LIGHT</b> EN</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Flashing blue light = TF card mode/ MP3 enabled.</li> <li>• Solid blue light = TF card / MP3 on pause or AUX mode enabled.</li> <li>• Flashing blue light = BT mode enabled.</li> <li>• Continuously flashing blue light = BT connection.</li> <li>• Solid red light = Charging.</li> <li>• Red light turns off = Charged.</li> <li>• Flashing red light = Low power.</li> </ul> <p><b>OTHER SPECIFICATIONS</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Insert the TF card to listen to music.
