

Introduction

Thank you for choosing QY8 Bluetooth Stereo Sports Headset, This manual will help you operate it , but you should first familiarize yourself with the Bluetooth function of your mobile phone or other devices before hand

General Functions

(the indicator light flashes blue slowly and you will hear the voice prompt

Enter the pairing mode: Press the " acc " button for 8 seconds when the device is off (the indicator flashes red and blue alternately, and you will hear the voice prompt "pairing")

Pairing: Pair the device with a mobile phone or other Bluetooth devices (refer to the below chapters about pairing for details)

Play/Pause: Press " ac= " to play or pause.

Volume up: Press ":" to turn up the volume.

Volume down: Press "." to turn down the volume.

Next /Previous: Press "," for 1 second to play previous track, and ":"

Power off: Press the " ocu " button for 3 seconds when the device is on or standby (you will hear the voice prompt "power off" and the indicator light

Low battery warning: You will hear the voice prompt "battery low" and the indicator light will flash red.

Charging: Use the USB charging cable connected to a computer to charge the headset (the indicator is solid red when charging) Answer a call: Press the " ese " button once to answer an incoming call

End a call: Press the " aca" button once to end an online call.

Transfer call voice: Press the " oc⇒ " button for 2 seconds to transfer the call voice from the mobile phone to the device or vice versa, Reject a call: Double press the " pew" button to reject an incoming call.

Multi-point connection: In power off mode, long press the " -----" button for 8 seconds to enter pairing mode, pair with the 1st mobile phone Power off QY8, turn off the Bluetooth function of the 1st mobile phone. function of the 2nd phone and select QY8 to pair with it. Turn on the

Bluetooth function of the 1st mobile phone to pair with OY8 and finish multi-point connection,

Switch calls between two mobile phones: When there's an incoming call on the 1st phone, press " oc= " to answer it; if there' s anothe incoming call on the 2nd phone at the same time, press " 🚥 " again to hang on the current call and answer the call on the 2nd

Redial the latest call: In standby or music playing mode, double press the " oc> " button

Mute: When talking, double press the " acr " button to activate the function Reset system: When charging the device, press the " ∞ " button for 3-5 seconds, the indicator light flashes purple for three times.

Turn off the voice prompt: Enter pairing mode, press "." for 3 seconds the indicator light flashes red for 3 times.

Turn on the voice prompt: Enter the pairing mode, press": for 3 seconds the indicator light flashes blue for 3 times

Charging Your Headset

1,Use a charger with DC5V output voltage or USB charging cable connected to a computer to charge the headset

2. During charging, the indicator light will turn red.

3. When the headset is fully charged, the red indicator light will turn blue.

Use only chargers approved by QCY, the use of any other chargers may invalidate warranty, and may be dangerous.

Repeated charging and discharging of the headset will cause the degradation of the battery performance. This is normal for all rechargeable batteries.

If the headset has not been used for over three months, please charge it



Pairing with a Computer

1. If your computer is not equipped with Bluetooth function, a Bluetooth adapter is necessary. Plug the adapter into your computer and ensure its Bluetooth function is activated (refer to the specification of the adapter for how to activate it).

2. Turn on the device and enter the paring mode.

3.Start the Bluetooth control software on your computer or the built-in software of the operating system, for example, the IVT software, and select

4,Once the headset is found, "name of Bluetooth" will be displayed in the devices list. Select the device, right dick and select, "pair with this device" Select the device again, right click and select "connect to audio device" 5. Open your media player to play music, watch TV/films or play games, then you can hear all the sound from the device

Pairing with a Phone

To use the Bluetooth headset, first you need to pair it with your phone or computer. If the headset was once paired with a phone, within operating range, they will automatically connect to each other in future: if with a mputer, you will just need to select "connect to audio device" in future

Pairing and using with your phone:

1. Activate the Bluetooth function on your phone and search for the Bluetooth headset (refer to the phone's User Manual). 2.Long press the multifunction button until the headset's indicator light flashes red and blue alternately. Now the headset goes into pairing state (you will hear the voice prompt "pairing")

3. Select the headset from the list of devices found by your phone 4.If a PIN code is required for pairing, enter "0000" to pair and connect the

5. When prompted by your phone to confirm this pairing, press the OK or YES key.


