






# A CLOSER LOOK





## **CHARGING**



Insert one end of the included charging cable into the charging port on your headphones.

Insert the other end into the USB port of a computer or suitable USB charging adapter.






# POWERING ON/OFF




Press and hold the power button for approximately 3-4 seconds to power on or power off your headphones.

### **BLUETOOTH PAIRING**



(Blue + Red Flashing)


Once powered on, your speaker will go into pairing mode. The LED Indicator will alternately flash blue and red.



Paired (Blue)

Once paired, the LED Indicator will stop flashing and remain blue.


## LISTENING TO MUSIC



Press the power button to play or pause music.

Press the Volume Up/Next Track button to skip to the next track in a playlist. Press and hold it to increase volume.






Press the Volume Down/Last Track button to return to the last track in a playlist. Press and hold it to decrease volume.


## **ADDITIONAL FEATURES**



Press the power button to pickup an incoming phone call or end a phone call. Press and hold to reject an incoming phone call.



Press the power button 2 times to access your phone's vocal assistant.



Press the power button 3 times to turn on or turn off low latency mode. This mode reduces the latency (time delay) inherent in Bluetooth connections. This mode provides the fastest sound feedback for mobile gaming.
