HOG NIGHTLIGHT UNIT FUNCTION

ON / OFF = Power Unit On or Off

GREEN = Green LED Illumination

RED = Red LED Illumination

MOTION = Motion Detection

DUSK = Dusk / Light Sensor Mode

(+) = LED Intensity Up

(-) = LED Intensity Down

REMOTE FUNCTION:

DUSK = Dusk/Light Sensor Mode

MOTION = Motion Detector Mode


RED = Red LED Illumination


GREEN = Green Illumination

(+) = LED Intensity Up

(-) = LED Intensity Down

(-) = Remote Wake Up Button





AREA LIGHT UNIT OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Power unit On/Off through **ON/OFF** Button.
2. Select desired color configuration by selecting **(RED)** or **(GREEN)** button(s).
3. Select desired LED intensity using Up (+) or Down (-) buttons.
4. Motion Detection Mode
 - a. Select color and intensity level.
 - b. Select **(MOTION)** button to turn on this function.
 - c. Select **(MOTION)** button again to turn off this function.
5. Dusk/Low light Mode
 - a. Select color and intensity level.
 - b. Select **(DUSK)** button to turn on this function.
 - c. Select **(DUSK)** button to turn off this function.

REMOTE OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Power Unit "ON" using the light unit itself.
2. "Wake" unit by pressing (-) button.
3. Select desired color using **(RED)** or **(GREEN)** buttons.
4. Activate/Deactivate "Motion" mode using **(MOTION)** button.
When activated, will illuminate for 15s, if no other motion is detected.
5. Activate/Deactivate "Dusk" mode using **(DUSK)** button

TROUBLESHOOTING:

1. UNIT LEDS ARE DIM

Replace Batteries in light unit.

2. ALL FUNCTIONS ARE FROZEN

Perform "Factory Reset" by switch power off, hold (-) button on unit, power back on. **All Green and Red LEDs should be on lowest intensity.**

3. REMOTE DOES NOT WORK

Press (-) button to wake unit. (*remote goes to sleep mode after 15s of inactivity*)

Replace A23 battery.
