INSTRUCTION MANUAL FOR i359(MEC-6192U) / i1105(MEC-6196U) COFFEE MILL (cETLus)

IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed, including the following:

- 1. Read all instructions.
- 2. To protect against risk of electrical shock, do not immerse the cord, plug, or the appliance in water or other liquid.
- 3. Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- 4. Unplug from outlet when not in use, before putting on or taking off parts, and before cleaning.
- 5. Avoid contacting moving parts.
- 6. Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug or after the appliance malfunctions, has been dropped or damaged in any manner. Return the appliance to the nearest authorized service facility for examination, repair or electrical or mechanical adjustment.

- 9. Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- 10. Check bean hopper for presence of foreign objects before using.
- 11. This appliance has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other). As a safety feature, this plug will fit in a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Do not attempt to defeat this safety feature.
- 12. This appliance is for household use only.
- 13. Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner or in a heated oven.
- 14. Do not use appliance for other than intended use.

SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS INSTRUCTION FOR USE

Before using your appliance for the first time, wipe the stainless steel bowl, blade, hopper and cover with a damp cloth. Allow to dry completely before using.

- 1. *Remove cover and place coffee beans into the stainless steel bowl. Do not exceed **50 grams.** of beans weighed at a time.
- 2. Place the cover on the appliance.
- 3. Plug in the appliance.
- 4. Hold the unit with one hand and make sure the cover is securely in place, press the button on the cover to switch-on with the other hand. To stop it, simply release the button. Do not remove the cover before the blades have stopped rotating.
- 5. *This appliance is intended for an operation maximum of **15 seconds on**.
- 6. Experimenting with the length of grind will enable you to get exactly the grind you prefer for the coffee.
- 7. When the blades have stopped...unplug the unit...remove the cover and the ground coffee.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

DO NOT IMMERSE THE MOTOR BASE IN WATER... DO NOT PLACE THE APPLIANCE IN THE DISHWASHER.

- 1. Before cleaning, unplug the appliance from electrical outlet.
- 2. Wash the cover in warm, soapy water. Rinse and dry completely.
- 3. Wipe the blades, stainless steel bowl, exterior and motor base with a damp cloth or paper towel to remove any excess ground coffee.
- 4. Any other servicing should be performed by an authorized service representative.

i359 Mobile App Usage Manual

Before using the mobile app, please understand that the app is a client for coffee mill, it does not work alone.

1. Open i359 app on your smartphone



2. Please press the button to connect i359 with your smartphone (ensure Bluetooth enabled).



3. the app searching your i359 device



4. Put the lid on flat surface with opening facing up



5. Select function "Grind" or "Measure"



6. Once you press "Grind", select your flavor as strength and fineness and number of cups




7. Measuring beans according to your flavor, put bean in the lid
