**Installation introduction**



Step 1: Connect the TV Box to your TV device.  
Step 2: Connect power.  
Step 3: Connect the router.

**Starting Display**

1. Turn on the TV and the TV box.

Lingcod TV Box has installed the commonly used applications. Enter the application, choose the APP you want, then the APP will be downloaded instantly.


**Apps uninstalling**
