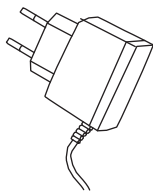

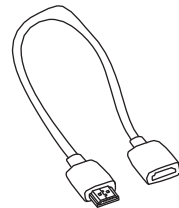

## Setup

### 1. CONNECT THE SIGNAGE STICK 2

Please connect the power supply to your Signage Stick 2 and use the HDMI extender to connect it to your screen.

### 2. SELECT INPUT SOURCE

Switch the input source of your screen until the viewneo setup view appears.

### 3. SET UP

Follow the instructions on your screen until the activation code is shown.

### 4. REGISTER YOUR ACCOUNT

Go to [www.viewneo.com/register](http://www.viewneo.com/register) to create your new account. Please log in now, select "License Key" and type in your personal License Key (see last page) to confirm.

### 5. PREPARE YOUR PROGRAM

Upload images or videos and create a playlist. Select "Devices / Groups" and create your first device group. Now click on "+" and type in the activation code from step 3 to complete the setup and add your Signage Stick 2 to your account.

## Einrichtung

### 1. DEN SIGNAGE STICK 2 ANSCHLIESSEN

SchlieÙe das Netzteil an und verbinde den Signage Stick 2 mit dem HDMI-Verlängerungskabel mit deinem Bildschirm.

### 2. QUELLE AUSWÄHLEN

Ändere die Eingangsquelle deines Bildschirms, bis die Setup-Ansicht von viewneo erscheint.

### 3. EINRICHTEN AM BILDSCHIRM

Folge nun den Anweisungen auf dem Bildschirm, bis der Aktivierungs-Code angezeigt wird.

### 4. DEINEN ACCOUNT REGISTRIEREN

Gehe auf [www.viewneo.com/de/register](http://www.viewneo.com/de/register) und lege dir einen viewneo Account an. Klicke nach dem ersten Login auf „Lizenzschlüssel“ und gib deinen License Key (siehe letzte Seite) an.

### 5. DEIN PROGRAMM VORBEREITEN

Lade Inhalte hoch und stelle eine Playlist zusammen. Wähle „Geräte / Gruppen“ und erstelle deine erste Gerätegruppe. Klicke nun auf „+“ und gib den angezeigten Aktivierungscode von Schritt 3 ein, um den Signage Stick 2 zu dieser hinzuzufügen.
