# Prepare your Fingbox

1

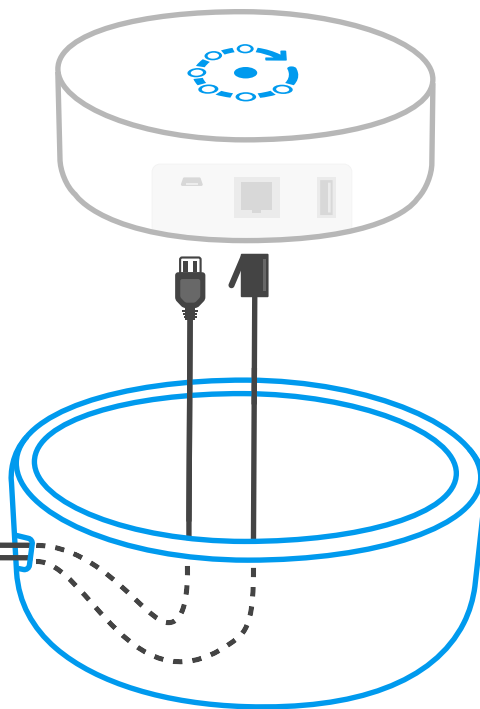
Pass the cables through the hole on the blue casing.

2

Plug the cables into the white casing.

3

Afterwards, put the white casing back inside the blue casing.



# Get the Fing App

Download the Fing mobile app by searching for “Fing” on the App Store or Google Play or by visiting [www.fing.io/fingbox](http://www.fing.io/fingbox)

Once the app is installed, navigate to the Fingbox tab which is found in the bottom menu bar in the far right.

Click on the Fingbox icon in the top right and follow the steps on the app to complete the set-up.
