## Instruction Manual


Pls read below instructions manual before using.

## Pairing instructions:

- 1. Plug speaker cable into port on transmitter
- 2. Locate power switch on transmitter and power on
- 3. Go to setting on Bluetooth device
- 4. Search for JLR GEAR and connect
- 5. Alert will sound on cooler bag speaker indicating a connection has been established. Blue indicator Light will illuminate on transmitter when device is connected
- 6. Play music

## Charging instrutions:

- 1. Unplug the speaker cable from transmitter.
- 2. Plug in mini USB charging cord into transmitter
- 3. Plug charging cord into a own USB power source, The red charging indicator light will illuminate
- 4. The charging light will turn off once charging is complete after approximately 2-3 hours
- 5. The speaker will shut down automatically when battery is low.
