The diagram illustrates the steps to connect the MP0W-H16 to a smartphone via Bluetooth:

- Step 1:**
 - Press the **ON** button (Long press 2s) to power on the device. The indicator light turns blue.
 - Press the **Pairing Mode** button (Long press 5-6s) to enter pairing mode. The indicator light turns red and blue.
 - Press the **OFF** button (Long press 4s) to turn off the device. The indicator light turns red.
- Step 2:**
 - On a smartphone, go to **Setting Bluetooth** and turn on the Bluetooth toggle.
 - Under **Not discoverable as "Phone" DEVICES**, select **MP0W-H16**.
 - Pair the device with the smartphone.
- Step 3:**
 - Press the **ON** button (Long press 2s) to power on the device. The indicator light turns green.

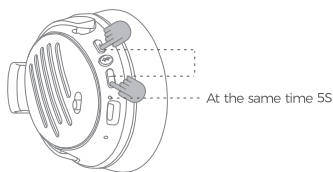

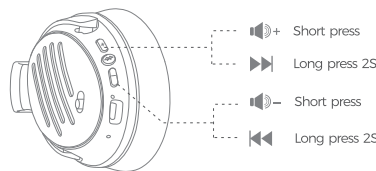
Diagram illustrating the Siri button on the back of the iPhone 12 Pro Max, showing various press combinations:
