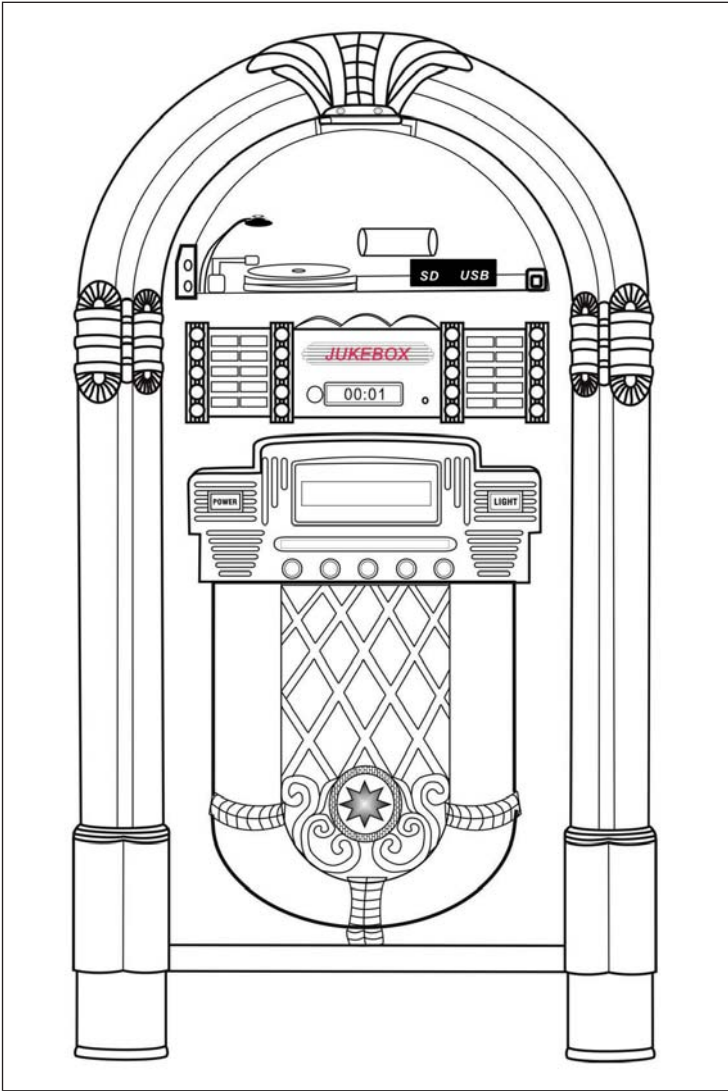

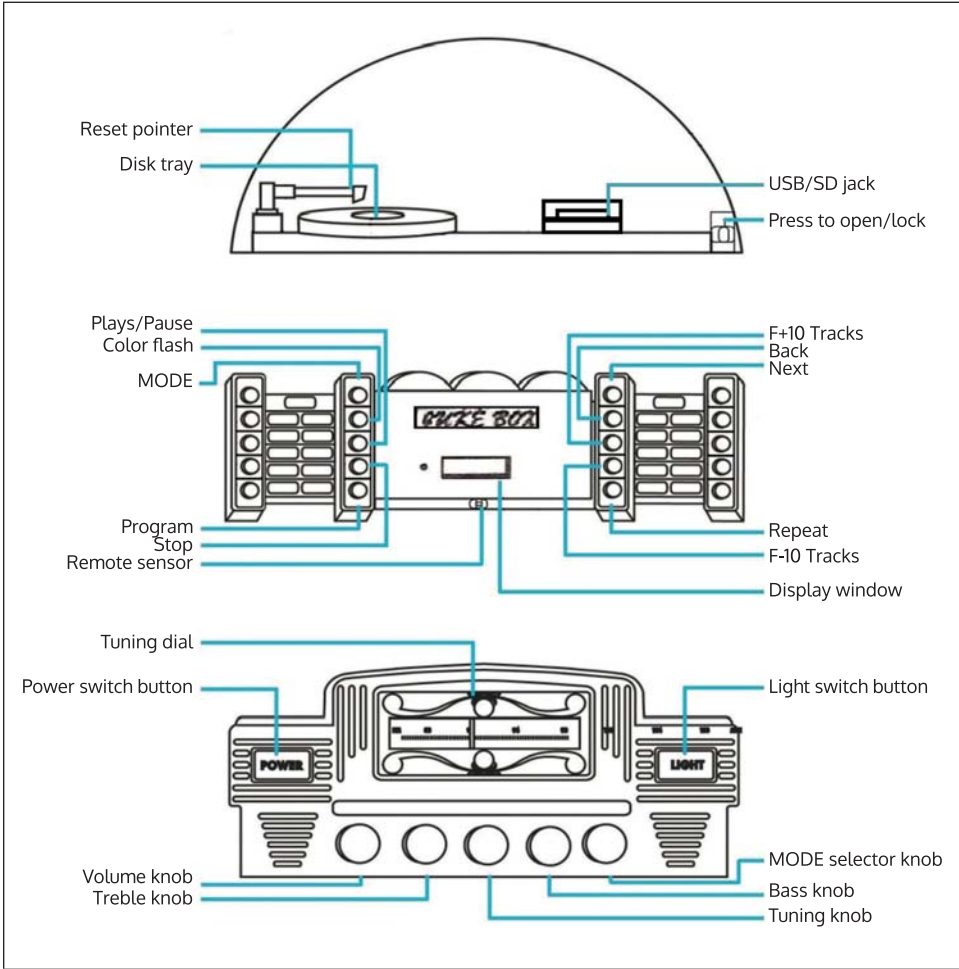

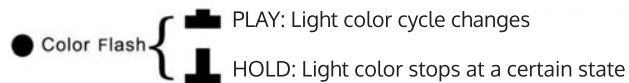


FUNCTIONS OF THE JUKEBOX

POWER	Power control switch of machine main control panel.
LIGHT (Light Button)	To Turn on/off the Led Lighting.
VOLUME (Volume control knob)	Turn the knob to increase or decrease volume.
TREBLE	Turn the knob to increase or decrease treble.
BASS	Turn the knob to increase or decrease bass.
MODE button	CD/USB/SD card--- when selected, you can playback from either CD, USB or SD memory card. To select between CD, USB or memory card, press the MODE button on the jukebox or on the remote control.
TUNING	For use when in FM radio mode. Turn the know left or right to tune to different radio stations. See the tuning dial above the controls to see the band.
MODE a knob (FM/CD.USB.SD/BT-AUX)	<p>A 3 position knob for 3 different functions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • FM radio: When selected, use the tuning knob to tune to different FM stations. • CD/USB/SD card: When selected, you can playback from either CD, USB or SD card. To select between CD, USB SD card, press the CD-MP3, USB SD mode button on the juke box or on the remote control. • BT-AUX in: When selected, you can playback from a connected Bluetooth or AUX in device.
Play/Pause:	Press to play or pause a track.
Stop	Press to stop a track. Press the play button to re-start music playback.

Next	Press to play the next track.
Back	Press to play the previous track.
F+10	Press to go forwards 10 tracks.

Repeat	Press to replay one particular song. The word REP will be displayed on the LCD display screen on the jukebox. Press the repeat button again will play the whole contents of the disc, USB stick, SD card . Press the repeat button again to exit the repeat mode (REP will not be displayed on the LCD screen).You can repeat an album (folder) when playing it in MP3 format.

COLOUR FLASH (Colour flash button)	When the lights are displayed (by turning on the main light button on the front of the jukebox), you can press the colour flash button to hold one color on the lights. Press again to resume colour changing.
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Press the colour flash button once to hold the lights colour. Press it again to resume colour changing. the Colour Changing LED Light Tubes will fade in and out of several different colours continuously, The lights can hold on 7 different colours (light blue, dark blue, green, pink, red, yellow or white). To turn OFF the lighting effects all together simply press the "LIGHT" button once again, and all lighting effects will no longer be illuminated.

Important notes for led lights: The colour changing sequences of the lights are controlled by an IC (Integrated Circuit). The lights may turn off when the light mode is in the HOLD position, this is normal and not a malfunction (need to adjust the switch).

FUNCTIONS OF THE REMOTE CONTROL

1	Play/Pause: press to play or pause a track.
2	Mode: press to change the mode of playback, choose from CD/USB/SD card.
3	Next: press to go to the next track.
4	F.F: long press fast forward, press to fast forward through a track. You can then press the playback button to start playback.
5	Back: press to go back one track.
6	F.B (fast back): long press press to rewind back through a track. You can then press the play button to start playback.
7	RAN (Random): press to playback in no particular order.

	PRG (Program): Allows you to program only particular songs of your choice to playback from your music source.
8	a While playing back from a music source, press the stop button.
	b Press the program button to enter the program mode. The word PROG will flash in the bottom left corner of the display screen. A position number will also be flashing on the screen (eg: p01).
	c Press the next or back buttons to select which track you want to program into position. When you have made your selection, press the program button to save it.
	d You can then repeat the same steps to fill in more positions.
	e When done, press play to begin your music playback. You can do this at any stage once you have programmed the amount of tracks you want.
	f At any stage during the program process you can press stop to cancel.
	g FUL will display on the LCD screen when the max amount of positions have been filled.
9	REP (Repeat): press „REP“ once to repeat one song, the REP indication at the top left corner on the led display will flash. Press the „REP“ display „REP FOLDER“ repeat album (MP3 music format). Press „REP“ one more time to repeat all songs in the track and the REP indication at the top left corner on the led display will appear. Press „REP“ again to cancel repeat function.
10	F-10: press to go back 10 previous tracks.
11	F+10: press to go forwards 10 tracks..
12	Stop button: press to stop a track.

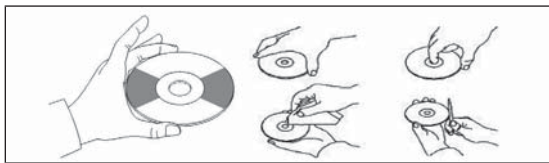
RADIO OPERATION

Put the mode selector switch to "FM" position respectively. Turn the Tuning knob to select your desire station. Adjust the volume by turning the Volume Control Knob.

CD/USB/SD CARD OPERATIONS

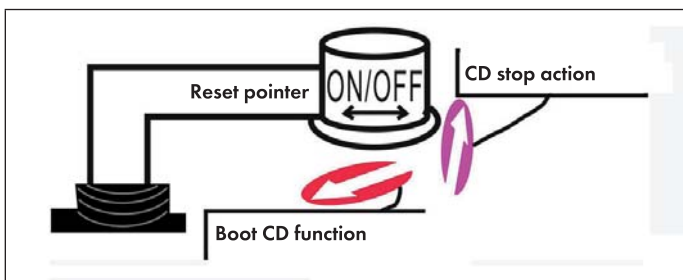
To access the top compartment to load a CD, USB or SD card, gently push in the bottom right corner of the display window. There is a push to open mechanism. You may close the window and push in again to have it shut. Put the mode selector switch to "CD/USB/SD" position. Select the CD mode by pressing the mode selector knob (CD/USB/SD) on the front panel until the display show "CD" Place a CD on to the disc tray. Take care not to touch the CD laser and ensure that the CD label is facing upwards.

Handling the Discs



- This unit has been designed specifically for sound reproduction from compact discs bearing the mark. No other discs can be used.
- To remove a disc from its storage case, press down on the center of the case and lift the disc out, holding it carefully by the edge.

Gently move the switch arm so that it is on top of the CD. The CD will then start spinning and play.



If the message "OP" appears on the juke boxes LCD display screen in the mode for CD playback, the tone arm has not been moved across so it is on top of the CD. The correct position is for the tone arm to be angled to the right and be on top of the CD.

To play a USB/SD card

- Set the mode selector switch to "CD/USB/SD" position.,
- Select the USB/SD card mode by pressing the mode selector knob (CD/USB/SD) on the front panel until the display show "USB or SD"Then, insert your USB or SD card into the respective slot.
- Once the tracks is showing on the display, press "Play/Pause" button to start playback.
- Press one more time to enter Pause mode. Press again to resume playing.
- Press Stop to stop playback
- Program Button: allows you to program only particular songs of your choice to playback from your music source.
- Next Button: Allow to play/select the next track
- Back Button: Allow to play/select the previous track
- F+10: Allow to go forward 10 tracks
- F-10: Allow to go backward 10 tracks

- Repeat: Allow to replay one particular song:
 - (1) Press „REP“ once to repeat one song, the REP indication at the top left corner on the led display will flash.
 - (2) Press the „REP“ display „REP FOLDER“ repeat album (MP3 music format.
 - (3) Press „REP“ one more time to repeat all songs in the track and the REP indication at the top left corner on the led display.
 - (4) Press „REP“ again to cancel repeat function.

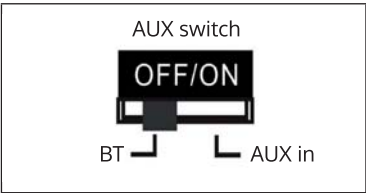

BT CONTROL



- Put the mode selector switch to "BT-AUX" position.,
- Adjust your settings on the Bluetooth device and ensure that Bluetooth connection is turned on.
- The LED light will be flashing on the Bluetooth indicator on the juke box. Pair your device with the jukebox. The device will be displayed as "JUKEBOX".
- When the red LED light begins to flash slowly, device and Bluetooth pairing has been successful and you can now begin your music playback.

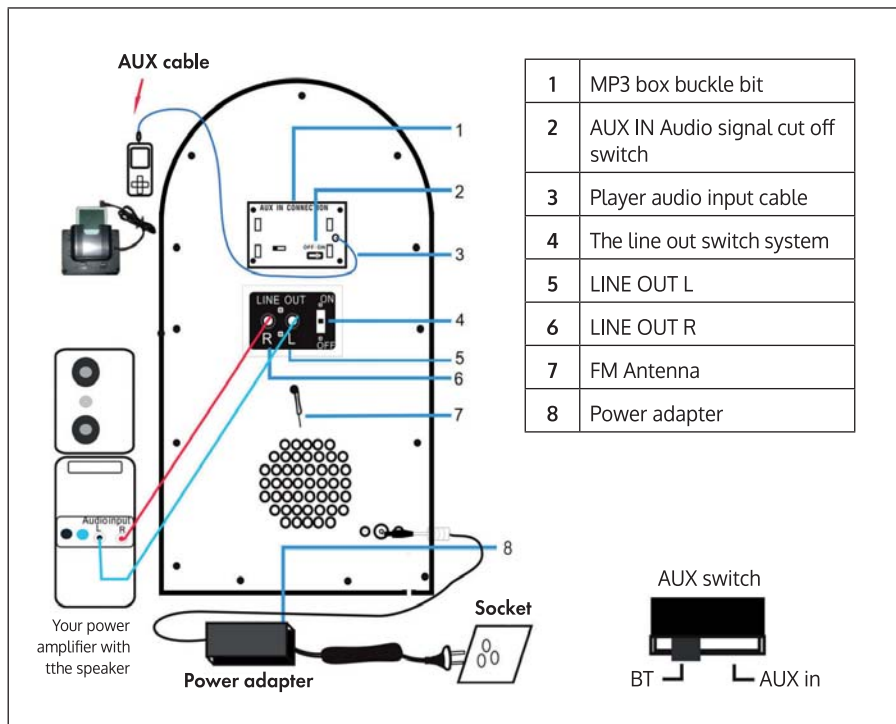
Note: If pairing of red LED does not blink, turn the selector switch off the "Bluetooth position" and try again. Also ensure the "AUX" in switch on the back of the jukebox is in the off position. It's on the back board of the machine.



BT operation

- Press the PLAY button for music playback, press again during music playback to pause music playback. Pressing the PLAY/PAUSE button when music is paused will resume music playback.
- DOWN: Press to play the next track.
- UP: Press to play the previous track.
- Vol-: Press to decrease volume.
- Vol+: Press to increase volume.

AUX IN AND LINE OUT OPERATIONS



Put the mode selector switch to "AUX-BT" position. AUX IN Audio signal cut-off switch to the „ON" position, after the completion of playback please set the switch to the " OFF" position. Ensure the function knob on the front of the jukebox is turned to AUX in position, the last setting on the knob.

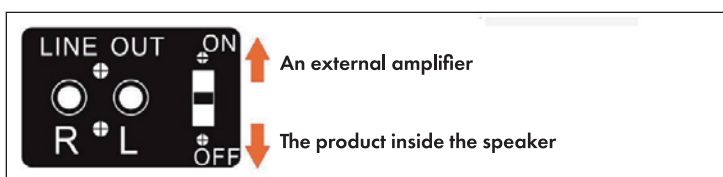
Plug the AUX in lead at the back of the jukebox into your mobile phone or iPhone/iPod or other MP3 device. The AUX lead needs to be plugged into the earphone socket of your iPhone/iPod or other MP3 device.

You can then begin playback from your mobile phone or iPhone/iPod or MP3 device. If you cannot hear anything, turn up the volume on the jukebox.

LINE OUT Jack with SPEAKER SWITCH

You have the option to use the line out ports to connect an external amplifier device, and the option to connect your own external speakers. „LINE OUT" switch system selection „ON". When LINE OUT audio is output to external power amplifier and speaker, the internal speaker of this product there is no sound.

If you do not connect anything to line out ensure the LINE OUT SWITCH is in the OFF position to playback through the jukebox.



TROUBLESHOOTING
