


Carefully remove items from package. Disconnect "Try Me" cable




The Racer's internal 9.6V rechargeable battery pack will need to be fully charged before play. To charge the battery, connect the battery pack to the included charging adapter. To insert battery, remove battery cover, insert and connect power lead to the car then replace battery cover and tighten screw.







Slide the power switch on the underside of the car to the ON position. For silent play, slide the power switch to the MUTE position.




Turn the remote ON. The Pairing/Power Indicator light on the remote will flash until it pairs up with the Racer. Once paired, the light will turn off. It will light whenever the remote is being used to control the Racer.











Steering Adjustment
