2.2 Assessment Results

Power density (S) is calculated according to the formula:

 $S = PG / (4\pi R^2)$

Where $S = power density in mW/cm^2$


P = Radiated transmit power in mW

G = numeric gain of transmit antenna

R = distance (cm)

As we can see from the test report 180701324SHA-001: The maximum radiated power = 25.74dBm = 374.97 mW; Here R is chosen to be 20cm,

 $S = P / (4\pi R^2) = 374.97 / (4 * 3.14 * 20 * 20) = 0.075 \text{ mW/cm}^2 < 1 \text{ mW/cm}^2$





Appendix I
