

TROUBLESHOOTING

Wireless Troubadour Headphones



MUSIC PLAYBACK

Play / Pause: Quickly press the power (也) button

Adjust Volume: Press & hold the corresponding volume button

Skip Forward: Quickly press the minus (-) button

Skip Backward: Quickly press the plus (+) button

PHONE CALLS / OTHER

Answer / End Call: Quickly press the power (ひ) button

Reject Call: Press the power (也) button for 2 seconds

On / Off: Press the power (也) button for 3 seconds

Voice Assistant: Press and hold the power (心) button for ~1 second Something not working? Don't panic. Try these helpful tips, and if afterwards you're still stuck, contact us at **hello@lstnsound.co**

MY TROUBADOURS WON'T TURN ON

Check to ensure that your Troubadours are charged. Plug the provided USB cable into a USB power supply. The LED indicator will turn red, and the headphones will begin charging. The LED will change to blue once your Troubadours are fully charged (apx. 1 hour). If you're unable to get to a charger, the provided backup cable works even when there is no battery power.

MY TROUBADOURS WON'T PAIR / CONNECT

Sometimes, connection errors happen. Try turning your device's Bluetooth connection off for a few seconds, and then try pairing again. If that doesn't work, turn off both your device's Bluetooth and the headphones for ~10 seconds, then start again.

MY CONNECTION IS SPOTTY / INTERMITTENT

The Troubadour's connection range is approximately 33 feet (10 m). Check the make sure you're in this range. They also work best with a direct line-of-sight connection, so make sure nothing is obstructing the path between your Troubadours and your device.

1) Hold the power (心) button down for ~5 seconds. The LED will flash red and blue. You'll hear an initial set of beeps when the power turns on, and a second set when the headphones begin pairing.

2) Open your device's Bluetooth preferences and select "Troubadours BT". You'll hear a beep to confirm the connection. If you're prompted to enter a PIN, use "0000".

3) That's it! You're now connected. To pair to a different device, simply turn off the headphones by holding the power button for 3 seconds, then restart this process at step 1 with your new device.

After completing the intial pairing process, your Troubadours will reconnect to the last used device once turned on - you do not need to re-pair them each time.

FCC Caution:
