


C. Access to the required information on the e-label

1. Users are able to access the information in no more than three steps in a device's menu.
The actual steps are:

Choose: Step 1: Power on > Step 2: information menu

No other special access codes or permissions are required to go through the above steps

2. The information is stored on the device, no special accessories or supplemental plug-ins (e.g., a SIM/USIM card) are required to access the information, not be modifiable by the user

Yes, the information is easy to be read, and can not modifiable.

3. Users are provided specific instructions on how to access the information:
