



CHARGE THE SPEAKER

You must charge the speaker fully before using this product for the first time. When the sound begin to trail off or distort, the red working indicator light will light up, it is time to charge the speaker.







Note: In order to prolong the battery life, please do not use it while it is being charged.

- 1. Connect one end of the provided USB charging cable to the USB charging socket on the speaker.
- 2.connect the other end of the provided USB charging cable to computer or adapter.
- 3.the charging indicator light is red when the speaker is being charged.
- 4. It takes about 8 10 hours to fully charge it if it is connected to computer. About 7 - 8 hours it connected to adapter(5V1.5A)
- 5. The charging indicator is extinguished when the speaker is full of electricity



POWER ON/OFF

- 1. Power on: long press the button " () "to trn on the
- 2. Power off: long press the button" (b) "again to turn off the speaker.

WIRELESS PAIRING

(1) Long press the power button" (1) to turn on the speaker, the blue working indicator light will flash fast



turn on the Wireless function on your phone. Search for Wireless devices and select " \$505 " (Enter code "0000" if needed."





(4) Now, you can play music, long press the power button once again to turn off the speaker when it is playing music.



Remark: The speaker has memory function. When you turn on the speaker next time, it will automatically connect to pre-paired phone if the Wireless function on you phone is on. (Please make sure your phone is in the range of pairing)

WIRELESS PLAYING

- 1. Hands-free call function: when a call comes in, short press" - "to answer it, long press it to reject, short press it again when you finish the call.
- 2.Redailing:double press the button" "to redial the last called number. And short press it again when you finish the call.
- 3. Long press" \(\sigma\)" to disconnect with the paired Wireless devices.
- 4. Short press the button" + "to skip to next track, long press to turn up the volume; short press the button" - "to skip to previous track, long press to turn down the volume.

AUX PLAYING

Some devices(such as MP3,MP4)have no Wireless function, so you can use the 3.5mm AUX audio cable to connect your device to the speaker to play music you can adjust volume on the speaker.

Note: After the speaker is on and without any operation for 10 minutes, it will turn off automatically.



CAUTIONS & WARNINGS

- 1. It is normal tat the speaker will produce slight heat when it is working or being charged.
- 2.DO NOT disassemble, dismantle, repair, modify, open, incinerate, paint, or insert foreign objects into the speaker without approval. Such actions may result in damage
- 3.DO NOT expose your speaker to extremely high or low temperatures.
- 4.DO NOT leave your speaker in direct sunlight for extended periods of time.
- 5.DO NOT leave your speaker near open flames such as cooking burners, candles, or fireplaces.
