
## **Google & Contacts**


- Adding a Google account A Google account lets you take full advantage of any Google apps and services that you may want to use. 1. Go to Settings > Accounts > + Add account 2. Select the account type. Google to add 3. Follow the onscreen instructions to enter information about the account.
