CHARGING THE BLUETOOTH WIRELESS AUDIO RECEIVER

The internal battery must be fully charged before first use of the wireless audio receiver. To charge, use the included USB charge cable:

1. Insert the smaller micro-USB end of the cable into the CHARGE INPUT on the wireless audio receiver. 2. Insert the larger USB end of the cable into the USB port of a computer OR into a compatible USB DC 5V wall charger (not included) to charge through a standard wall outlet. The indicator lights up red during charging and will turn blue when charging is complete. Unplug from the power source when charging is complete.

NOTE: Low audio receiver power and/or low audio device power may cause poor operation and/or no Bluetooth connection. Recharge as described above



BLUETOOTH WIRELESS AUDIO OPERATION

- 1. Make sure the wireless audio receiver battery is charged as explained above.
- 2. Insert one end of the included 3.5 mm connector plug into the audio output jack on the audio receiver unit - then plug the other end into the 3.5 mm audio input/auxiliary/line-in jack of your car stereo system.
- 3. Turn on your car stereo system and be sure it is set to the audio input/auxiliary/line-in mode. 4. On the guidio receiver unit, press and hold the POWER/PLAY BUTTON until the indicator light flashes blue and red - this means the Bluetooth function is active and ready to connect to your smartphone/Bluetooth audio device. NOTE: If you do not connect the earbuds with a Bluetooth device after 5 minutes of being turned on, the earbuds will turn off automatically. Restart this step to try to connect again.
- 5. Activate Bluetooth function on your audio device it should automatically recognize the Bluetooth wireless audio receiver and allow you to select it using the name "iWorld". If required, enter the password "0000" to

complete the wireless connection. When the earbuds are connected, the indicator light on the controller will flash blue and you are now set to enjoy wireless audio from within a 33ft range of the audio device.

- 6. Before playback, first adjust the volume of your audio device to medium level as a safe starting point.
- 7. To play audio, click the POWER/PLAY BUTTON once.
- 8. To pause audio, click the POWER/PLAY BUTTON once,
- 9. To increase the volume, press and hold the + button. To decrease the volume, press and hold the button. There will be a chime sound when maximum volume is reached. You may then adjust the volume on your audio device to make it even louder or softer as you please.
- 10. To go to the next song, click the + button. To go to the previous song, click the button.
- 11. To answer an incoming call, click the POWER/PLAY BUTTON once.
- 12. To end a phone call, click the POWER/PLAY BUTTON once.
- 13. To disconnect and shut off the wireless audio receiver unit, press and hold the POWER BUTTON for several seconds until the indicator light goes out,
