## 2.2 Assessment Results

Power density (S) is calculated according to the formula:

 $S = P / (4\pi R^2)$ 

Where  $S = power density in mW/cm^2$ 


P = Radiated transmit power in mW

G = numeric gain of transmit antenna

R = distance (cm)

As we can see from the test report 190700517SHA-001: The maximum radiated power = 20.36dBm = 108.64 mW; Here R is chosen to be 20cm,

 $S = P / (4\pi R^2) = 108.64 / (4 * 3.14 * 20 * 20) = 0.0216 \text{ mW/cm}^2 < 1 \text{ mW/cm}^2$ 





## Appendix I
