Setting a PIN:

- 1. Locate the learn button on the back of the opener hanging in your garage.
- 2. Press and release the learn button (the next step must be completed within 30 seconds of releasing the learn button)
- 3. Enter a unique 4 digit PIN on the keypad then press and hold ENTER on the keypad
- 4. Hold the ENTER button until the lights flash on the opener or you hear two "clicks".
- 5. The PIN is now set. Test operation.

Operation:

- 1. Open Enter 4 digit PIN then press ENTER on the keypad
- 2. Close Press the ENTER button twice (Do not enter PIN to close)
