5	The module must demonstrate compliance in a stand-alone configuration;	<input type="radio"/>	
6	The module must be labeled with its permanently affixed FCC ID label, or use an electronic display (see KDB Publication 784748);	<input type="radio"/>	
7	The module must comply with all specific rules applicable to the transmitter, including all the conditions provided in the integration instructions by the grantee;	<input type="radio"/>	
8	The module must comply with RF exposure requirements	<input type="radio"/>	

A limited modular approval may be granted for single or split modular transmitters that do not comply with all of the above requirements, e.g., shielding, minimum signaling amplitude, buffered modulation/data inputs, or power supply regulation, if the manufacturer can demonstrate by alternative means in the application for equipment authorization that the modular transmitter meets all the applicable Limited modular approval also may be granted in those instances where compliance with RF exposure rules is demonstrated only for particular product configurations. The applicant for certification must state how control of the end product into which the module will be installed will be maintained such that full compliance of the end product is always ensured.
