### 1. Button

# 1.1 Touch panel

Capacitive touch panel: In The Operation, drag on the touch panel

### 1.2 POWER

Startup: Long Press and hold the power button, the system will enter the main in terface

Shutdown: In the main menu interface, press the power button for about 5 seconds to shutdown, The system will display a "power off" option. Press 'OK'. Device can now be safely switched off.

Lock screen: Short press Power button to lock screen or unlock screen.

Remark 1. When device is out of battery, system will shut down automatically.

2. If device is not properly turned off, the device will restart and restore the disk and may take a longer time to start

### 1.3 Volume +, Volume-

The buttons on top Volume + and Volume will change the volume.

### 1.4 Earphone Jack

3.5 mm standard earphone jack

### 1.5 TF card

TF-CARD slot: external T-FLASH card

#### 1.6 Mini USB

Mini USB jack: you can use it to connect the computer for data transmission, charging and external connection USB flash drive

### 1.7 Reset

If the Tablet crashes, use a small objects to short press RESET button. Tablet will be forced to shutdown.

【Remark】:, Don't use the reset unless unable to shutdown. It is advised to shut the system normally, otherwise device will be damaged.

# 2.1 Battery management and charge

Before first use, please set the device's battery is fully charged Just need to connect the adaptor or USB interface, then you can charge

The first two times charging please keep about 6 hours, after that you just need 4 hours to charge.

【Remark】: This tablet using Built-in type polymer battery, Charger must be to choose standard adaptor (Input: AC110~240V 50/60Hz Max: 180MA.. Output: DC5.0~5.5V/1.5A), this device without supply DC charging, USB interface can charge, Choose USB interface to charger

During the charging, the battery icon will scroll

When finished charging, battery icon will become green and stop rolling


In order to prolong the service life of the machine, suggest use out battery power before charge it

[Remark]: 1. If you don't use the device for a long time, in order to avoid damage caused by power consumption, charge or switch on the device once a month.

2. If device shuts down due to low battery, connect DC adaptor, device might not switch on till there is enough power to enter into the main menu.

# 2.2 Connection with PC

Use USB cable to connect device to PC, device will display the USB connection window, click Turn on USB storage to connect to PC




In the loading screen, you can copy or delete the file on the device and on the memory card.

# 3. Equipment operation interface


3.1 Main interface

After startup you will enter the main interface




In the main interface, you can:

Manage the main interface software ICONS: long press the icons for 3 secon, when the icons increase in size, you can drag them anywhere in the interface




Delete icons: long press an icon for 3 seconds, drag the icons to the Recycle Bin icon, till it becomes red


If you keep the screen pressed, an "Add to Home screen" dialogue box will appear as shown below:





Setting: Click setting icons , to enter setting interface






Unknown sources: Click "Unknown Sources",

【Remark】: when are upgrading the Firmware, please close the USB connect


### How to uninstall?

- 2. Clicking the uninstall icons, will bring up the following interface




3. Click Uninstall, then you can delete the application


Remove TF card, view the available storage space

Remark: Android system can support 54 different languages, however the menu interface supports 14 different languages,


Keyboard & input method: Android keyboard setting

Show suggestions: Display suggested words while typing


Auto-complete: Spacebar and punctuation automatically insert highlighted word

# 5.1 App installer

This Tablet can support Android APP in market by third party, most Apps can install in the network, and can copy to NAND FLASH or SD card.

Click App installer icon, will bring up 'Install', 'Manage' and 'Exit' options.

Install: Click install, enter Apk install interface

Separately for Internal Memory disk and SD Card disk.

Select the APK you would like to install, click it to install, go back to main menu to display

the installed app you just selected.

Remark: some 3<sup>rd</sup> party apps must be installed properly on the memory card, downloaded 3<sup>rd</sup> party apps may not install properly on this device.

Manage: click manage, enter third party interface, Click install icon to enter Action interface

### 6. Troubleshooting

Device does not start

- i. Check the battery power
- ii. Connect adaptor first, then check again
- iii. If device does not switch on even after full charge, contact the supplier

After startup if the device shuts down

1. Power is not enough, please charge

No sound can be heard in the headset

- 1. Please check whether the volume is set to 0
- 2. Check whether the music file is damaged. Try playing another music file, to see if the file is damaged.

Cannot copy files or play music

- 1. Please check if the computer and device are properly connected
- 2. Check if the memory storage space is already full
- 3. Check if the USB cable is working properly
- 4. Check if the USB connection has been disconnected
