### How to Wear the Headset

- 1) Choose the right earplugs so as to fit your ears.
- 2) Adjust the headset to a comfortable position.
- 3) Start your music journey.





### How to Charge the Headset

When used for the first time, it is recommended to charge the headset before using.

Place the headset in the charging box, the indicator light will be white.

The remaining capacity of charging box is divided into 4 levels, namely: 25%>50%>75%>100%.

### Function Operation

Function	Operation
Power on	Automatically power on by taking out of charging box.
Power off	Automatically power off by putting into the charging box.
Play/Pause	Click the function button.
Wake up or not	Long press the function button. It's in standby mode.
Answer	Press the function button once when calling.
Hang up	Press the function button once during talking.
Repeat	Long press the function button. It's when calling.
Volume +	Press twice the function button to increase the volume.
Volume -	Press three times the function button to reduce the volume.


### How to Pair the Headset

1) Take the earbuds out of the charging box, and the headset will automatically power on and enter into the state of the red and blue light alternately flashing.

2) Simultaneously press and hold on the function button until the blue light flashes (the red and blue light stop flashing alternately), wait for the headphones to complete the pairing automatically.

3) Press and hold successfully, the light earbuds enter into the pairing mode. The red and blue light flash alternately while the left earphone's indicator light does not flash.

4) Complete the pairing with your phone according to the method described above.



### Advanced Operation: Unpair

When the headphones need to be used simultaneously for a single ear, the following operations are needed to cancel them so as to prevent their automatic interconnection.

Put the headset into the charging box, press the headset to enter into the charging state (the light is constantly on) take out a headset and then into the Bluetooth search state.

1. Take the earbuds out of the charging box, and the headset will automatically power on and enter into the state of the red and blue light alternately flashing.

2. Simultaneously press and hold on the function button until the blue light flashes (the red and blue light stop flashing alternately), wait for the headphones to complete the pairing automatically.

3. Press and hold successfully, the light earbuds enter into the pairing mode. The red and blue light flash alternately while the left earphone's indicator light does not flash.

4. Complete the pairing with your phone according to the method described above.

### Q&A

**Q: Why can't my headset be charged?**  
**A:** Please cover the charging touch lid and keep the charging contact clean.

**Q: Why can't my headset be powered on?**  
**A:** Please recharge it and make sure the headset has enough power. Put the headset into the charging box to check if the indicator light is constantly red.

**Q: Why can't the two headphones be paired with each other?**  
**A:** Put the two headphones each into the charging box for 5 minutes to reset, and then return them out of the charging box and pair from according to the method for first use.

**Q: The wireless headset's signal is not good?**  
**A:** Bluetooth is a short-range wireless communication technology. When we say that it has a transmission range of 10 meters, each range does not include all kinds of environment and special circumstances. Please check whether there is any electromagnetic interference around.

**Q: Why can't I hear the other when I'm on the phone, or listening to music?**  
**A:** Please confirm the following points:  
 1) When you're on the phone, please select the speaker mode as "Wide BT LE".  
 2) When there is a call, please click the multi-function button on the headset to answer it.  
 3) The connection modes of this wireless headset include "mobile audio" and "multimedia audio". Please confirm that both are allowed on your mobile phone.  
**Q: Why can't the headset pair with my device?**  
**A:** Please confirm the following points:  
 1) Please confirm whether the headset is powered on and enters into the pairing mode (the right headphones is red and blue alternately flashing; and the left headphones is blue flashing blue light).  
 2) Please confirm whether the headset has been connected to other devices. If so, please disconnect and close the Bluetooth of that device.  
 3) Please confirm whether the headset is within the range of 10 meters.  
 4) If the above steps cannot solve the problem, please contact our after-sales service.

### Notes:

- \*Please use this headset according to local laws and regulations.
- \*Please place the headset in a place where children can't reach them. Swallowing some parts can lead to severe consequences, such as suffocation.
- \*Please don't place the headset in an extreme cold or heat (below 0°C (32°F) higher than 45°C (113°F) place, it will lead to the device have deterioration, reduce its battery's charging capacity and shorten its service life.
- \*Please don't use the device or operate it with wet hands because liquid will damage the device.
- \*Please don't sleep if you think you're too long hours, so the will damage your hearing.
- \*Please don't touch the product or wear earbuds to avoid the battery life.
- \*Standard 5pin USB interface, please use the charger of 2V 1A to charge the charging box. Please note that if the product is not used for a long time, the battery capacity will slowly drain away.
- \*Caution: Improper use of battery in the product may cause fire or chemical burns. The battery may explode in case of damage.
- \*Choose the battery according to local regulations. Recycle, if possible. Don't dispose the battery or "household garbage or throw into the bin as waste and any explosion.
