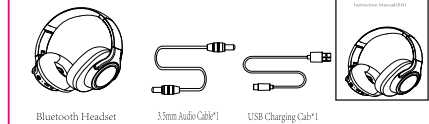


H01 Wireless Headphones

Package Contents

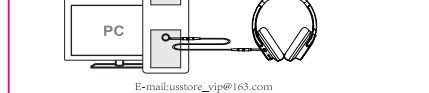


1. Turn off the headset, use the charging cable to connect the charged, the red LED will turn off, charger/computer/charging bank/etc to charge. Note: Before using the headset for the first time charge for at least 2 hours.
2. The red LED will turn on to indicate that the unit is charging. Once fully charged, the red LED will turn off. Tip: Do not turn on the headset when charging headset or else it will lower the quality and the life of battery.

Contents

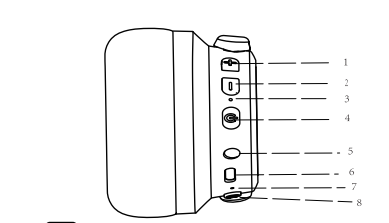
1. Place headset within 10M from Bluetooth-enabled device.
2. Long press 2s, the headset will be turned on. You will hear a prompt.
3. After opening the phone Bluetooth, click the H01 to pair.
4. The headset will automatically turn off after 5 minutes without pairing. Note: If the white light flashes quickly, the Bluetooth is not connected. If the white indicator blinks slowly, the Bluetooth is connected. If the red light is steady on the being charged.

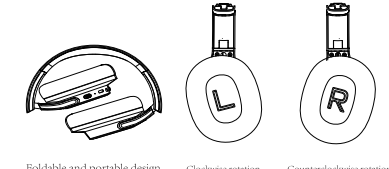

1. Long press 1s: The prev song
Press once: Volume+
2. Long press 1s: The next song
Press once: Volume-
3. LED indicator
4. Long press 2s: Power on
Long press 3s: Power off
Press once: Play/pause
Press once: call control/hang up
Three-click button: Call back
5. 3.5mm AUX port
6. Type-C Charging Port
7. MIC
8. EQ indicator
