- Flashing white - ready to pair

**selfie remote**

- Remove the selfie remote from the tripod stand.
- Hold the camera button to power on, be sure to remove the protective film on the battery.
- The indicator light will flash white when it is ready to pair.
- Use the Bluetooth settings on your phone to pair with "HEYDAY REMOTE 01"
- The remote is connected when the indicator light turns solid white.
- Open the camera on your phone and use the camera button to take pictures.
- The remote will automatically shut down after 10 minutes of no use, hold the camera button to turn the selfie remote off.
- If the indicator light is flashing red the remotes battery is low, replace the CR2032 battery.

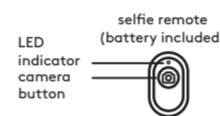

If the remote is not working or the indicator light is flashing red, you will need to replace the battery. First, use a flat edge tool like a coin or screwdriver to rotate the center slot clockwise 90 degrees to the unlock position.

Next, flip the remote over so that the back of the remote is facing down and then tap the front of the remote to remove the battery cover.

After the battery is properly inserted, replace the battery cover and use the flat edge tool like a coin or screwdriver to rotate the center slot counterclockwise to the lock position.
