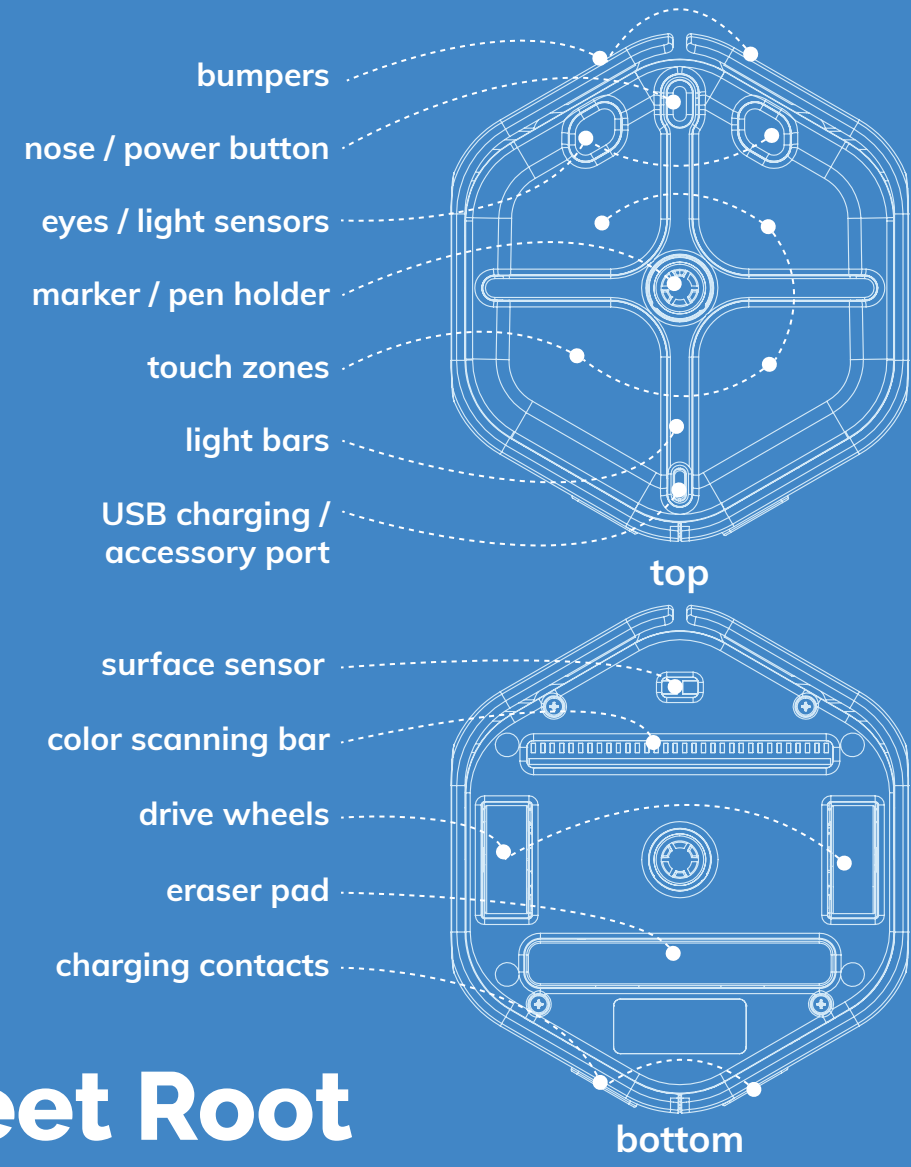
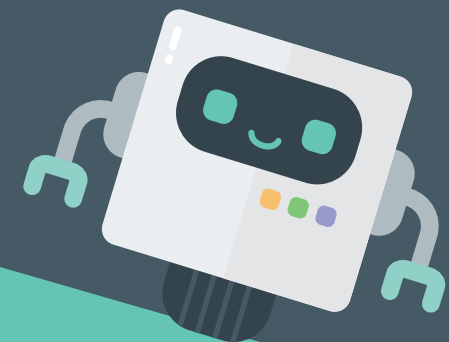
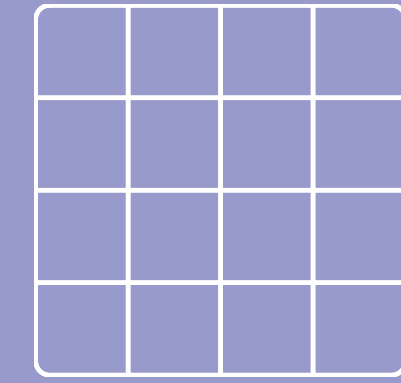

What's Included:

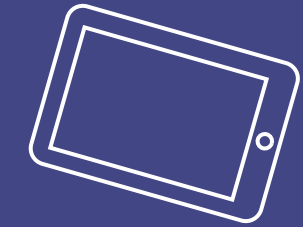

Getting Started:

Remove the cardboard shipping tab from the bottom of Root.

2

Use the cable provided to plug Root into a USB charger. Root will start flashing yellow to indicate charging. Root will light up green when charging is complete.

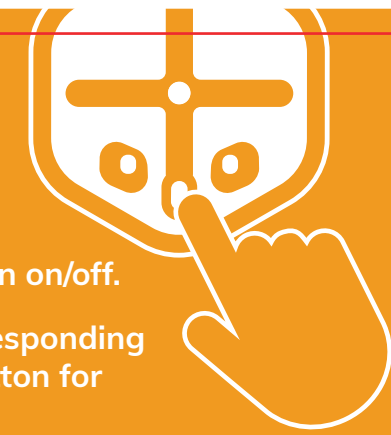

Download and install the Root Coding app on your mobile device.

Tips:



Turning Root On/Off - Press the nose button until the lights turn on/off.

Hard Reset Root - If Root is not responding as expected, hold the nose button for 10 seconds to turn Root off.

Low Battery Warning - If Root flashes red, then the battery is low and needs to be charged.

Clicking Noise - Root's drive wheels have internal clutches to prevent damage to the motors if Root is pushed or gets stuck.

Pen / Marker Compatibility - Root's marker holder will work with most standard sizes. The pen or marker should not touch the surface underneath until Root lowers the marker holder.

Eraser Pad Cleaning / Replacement - Root's eraser pad is held in place with a hook-and-loop fastener. To service simply peel off the eraser pad and wash. Note that Root's eraser only works on magnetic whiteboards.
