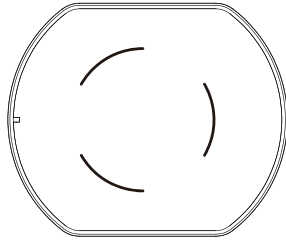

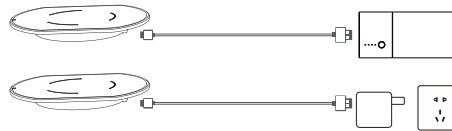

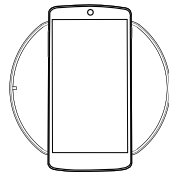
Please read the manual carefully before use.

Using Your Wireless Charging Pad

1. Plug it into a USB charger or power bank (as below Pic).



2. Place your phone or tablet on the center of your wireless charging pad.



3. LED Indication

- Ready to charge: Light is off.
- Charging: Solid blue.
- Error: Blinking blue.
