2.2 Test Mode

- a. The EUT has been associated with peripherals and configuration operated in a manner tended to maximize its emission characteristics in a typical application. Frequency range investigated: conduction (150 kHz to 30 MHz), radiation (9 kHz to the 10th harmonic of the highest fundamental frequency or to 40 GHz, whichever is lower). Pre-scanned tests, X, Y, Z in three orthogonal panels to determine the final configuration (X plane as worst plane) from all possible combinations.
- b. AC power line Conducted Emission was tested under maximum output power.





2.6 Measurement Results Explanation Example

For all conducted test items:

The offset level is set in the spectrum analyzer to compensate the RF cable loss between EUT conducted output port and spectrum analyzer. With the offset compensation, the spectrum analyzer reading level is exactly the EUT RF output level.

Example :

The spectrum analyzer offset is derived from RF cable loss.

Offset = RF cable loss.

Following shows an offset computation example with cable loss 5.5 dB.

 $Offset(dB) = RF \ cable \ loss(dB).$ = 5.5 (dB)



3.1.3 Test Procedures

- 1. The testing follows ANSI C63.10-2013 clause 11.8
- 2. The RF output of EUT was connected to the spectrum analyzer by RF cable and attenuator. The path loss was compensated to the results for each measurement.
- 3. Set to the maximum power setting and enable the EUT transmit continuously.
- Make the measurement with the spectrum analyzer's resolution bandwidth (RBW) = 100 kHz. Set the Video bandwidth (VBW) = 300 kHz. In order to make an accurate measurement. The 6 dB bandwidth must be greater than 500 kHz.
- For 99% Bandwidth Measurement, the spectrum analyzer's resolution bandwidth (RBW) is set 30kHz and set the Video bandwidth (VBW) = 100kHz.
- 6. Measure and record the results in the test report.







99% Occupied Bandwidth Plot on Channel 11



3.2 Peak Output Power Measurement

3.2.1 Limit of Peak Output Power

For systems using digital modulation in the 2400-2483.5MHz, the limit for peak output power is 30dBm. If transmitting antenna of directional gain greater than 6dBi is used, the peak output power from the intentional radiator shall be reduced below the above stated value by the amount in dB that the directional gain of the antenna exceeds 6 dBi. In case of point-to-point operation, the limit has to be reduced by 1dB for every 3dB that the directional gain of the antenna exceeds 6dBi.



- The testing follows the Measurement Procedure of ANSI C63.10-2013 clause 11.9.1.3 PKPM1 Peak power meter method.
- 2. The RF output of EUT was connected to the power meter by RF cable and attenuator. The path loss was compensated to the results for each measurement.
- 3. Set to the maximum power setting and enable the EUT transmit continuously.
- 4. Measure the conducted output power and record the results in the test report.

3.3 Power Spectral Density Measurement

3.3.1 Limit of Power Spectral Density

The peak power spectral density shall not be greater than 8dBm in any 3kHz band at any time interval of continuous transmission.


3.3.2 Measuring Instruments

3.3.3 Test Procedures

- 1. The testing follows Measurement Procedure of ANSI C63.10-2013 clause 11.10.2 Method PKPSD.
- 2. The RF output of EUT was connected to the spectrum analyzer by RF cable and attenuator. The path loss was compensated to the results for each measurement.
- 3. Set to the maximum power setting and enable the EUT transmit continuously.
- Make the measurement with the spectrum analyzer's resolution bandwidth (RBW) = 3 kHz.
 Video bandwidth VBW = 10 kHz In order to make an accurate measurement, set the span to 1.5 times DTS Channel Bandwidth. (6dB BW)
- 5. Detector = peak, Sweep time = auto couple, Trace mode = max hold, Allow trace to fully stabilize. Use the peak marker function to determine the maximum power level.
- 6. Measure and record the results in the test report.
- 7. The Measured power density (dBm)/ 100kHz is a reference level and used as 20dBc down limit line for Conducted Band Edges and Conducted Spurious Emission.




PSD 100kHz Plot on Channel 19






PSD 3kHz Plot on Channel 19

3.4.1 Limit of Conducted Band Edges and Spurious Emission

All harmonics/spurious must be at least 20 dB down from the highest emission level within the authorized band.

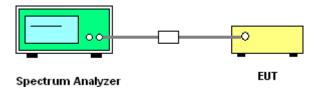

3.4.3 Test Procedure


- 1. The testing follows ANSI C63.10-2013 clause 11.13
- 2. The RF output of EUT was connected to the spectrum analyzer by RF cable and attenuator. The path loss was compensated to the results for each measurement.
- 3. Set to the maximum power setting and enable the EUT transmit continuously.
- 4. Set RBW = 100 kHz, VBW=300 kHz, Peak Detector. Unwanted Emissions measured in any 100 kHz bandwidth outside of the authorized frequency band shall be attenuated by at least 20 dB relative to the maximum in-band peak PSD level in 100 kHz when maximum peak conducted output power procedure is used. If the transmitter complies with the conducted power limits based on the use of RMS averaging over a time interval, the attenuation required under this paragraph shall be 30 dB instead of 20 dB.
- 5. Measure and record the results in the test report.
- 6. The RF fundamental frequency should be excluded against the limit line in the operating frequency band.




3.4.5 Test Result of Conducted Band Edges Plots


High Band Edge Plot on Channel 26



Conducted Spurious Emission Plot on Zigbee Channel 11










Conducted Spurious Emission Plot on Zigbee Channel 19



Conducted Spurious Emission Plot on Zigbee Channel 19






3.5.3 Test Procedures

- 1. The testing follows ANSI C63.10-2013 clause 11.11 & 11.12
- 2. The EUT was arranged to its worst case and then tune the antenna tower (from 1 m to 4 m) and turntable (from 0 degree to 360 degrees) to find the maximum reading. A pre-amp and a high pass filter are used for the test in order to get better signal level.
- 3. The EUT was placed on a turntable with 0.8 meter for frequency below 1GHz and 1.5 meter for frequency above 1GHz respectively above ground.
- 4. The EUT was set 3 meters from the interference receiving antenna, which was mounted on the top of a variable height antenna tower.
- 5. Corrected Reading: Antenna Factor + Cable Loss + Read Level Preamp Factor = Level
- For conducted spurious emission measurement in the restricted band, the RF output of EUT was connected to the spectrum analyzer by RF cable and attenuator. The path loss was compensated to the results for each measurement.
- 7. For measurement below 1GHz, if the emission level of the EUT measured by the peak detector is 3 dB lower than the applicable limit, the peak emission level will be reported. Otherwise, the emission measurement will be repeated using the quasi-peak detector and reported.
- 8. Use the following spectrum analyzer settings:
 - (1) Span shall wide enough to fully capture the emission being measured;
 - (2) Set RBW=100 kHz for f < 1 GHz; VBW \geq RBW; Sweep = auto; Detector function = peak; Trace = max hold;
 - (3) Set RBW = 1 MHz, VBW= 3MHz for $f \ge 1$ GHz for peak measurement. For average measurement:
 - VBW = 10 Hz, when duty cycle is no less than 98 percent.
 - VBW ≥ 1/T, when duty cycle is less than 98 percent where T is the minimum transmission duration over which the transmitter is on and is transmitting at its maximum power control level for the tested mode of operation.




For radiated emissions from 30MHz to 1GHz

3.6 AC Conducted Emission Measurement

3.6.1 Limit of AC Conducted Emission

For equipment that is designed to be connected to the public utility (AC) power line, the radio frequency voltage that is conducted back onto the AC power line on any frequency or frequencies within the band 150 kHz to 30 MHz shall not exceed the limits in the following table.



3.6.3 Test Procedures

- 1. The EUT was placed 0.4 meter from the conducting wall of the shielding room was kept at least 80 centimeters from any other grounded conducting surface.
- 2. Connect EUT to the power mains through a line impedance stabilization network (LISN).
- 3. All the support units are connecting to the other LISN.
- 4. The LISN provides 50 ohm coupling impedance for the measuring instrument.
- 5. The FCC states that a 50 ohm, 50 microhenry LISN should be used.
- 6. Both sides of AC line were checked for maximum conducted interference.
- 7. The frequency range from 150 kHz to 30 MHz was searched.
- Set the test-receiver system to Peak Detect Function and specified bandwidth (IF Bandwidth = 9kHz) with Maximum Hold Mode. Then measurement is also conducted by Average Detector and Quasi-Peak Detector Function respectively.

3.7 Antenna Requirements

3.7.1 Standard Applicable

If directional gain of transmitting antennas is greater than 6dBi, the power shall be reduced by the same level in dB comparing to gain minus 6dBi. The use of a permanently attached antenna or of an antenna that uses a unique coupling to the intentional radiator shall be considered sufficient to comply with the rule.

3.7.2 Antenna Anti-Replacement Construction

Non-standard antenna connector is used.

3.7.3 Antenna Gain

The antenna peak gain of EUT is less than 6 dBi. Therefore, it is not necessary to reduce maximum peak output power limit.
