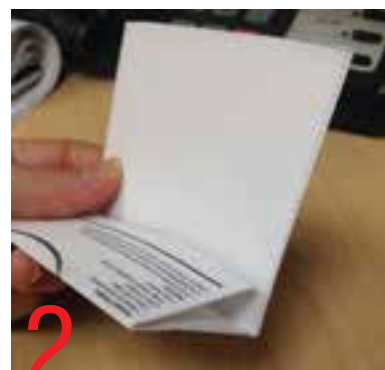

TROUBLESHOOTING

No power	Recharge your earbuds using the included Micro USB charging cable
Music is not playing over bluetooth	Make sure your Bluetooth device has A2DP profile. Check if both devices are paired and connected over Bluetooth. Restart the earbuds to reconnect your Bluetooth device.
Bluetooth device will not reconnect with the earbuds	Navigate to your Bluetooth settings menu on your Bluetooth device, tap "UZ-BTE85", and select "Forget". Now follow the steps to pair your device again.

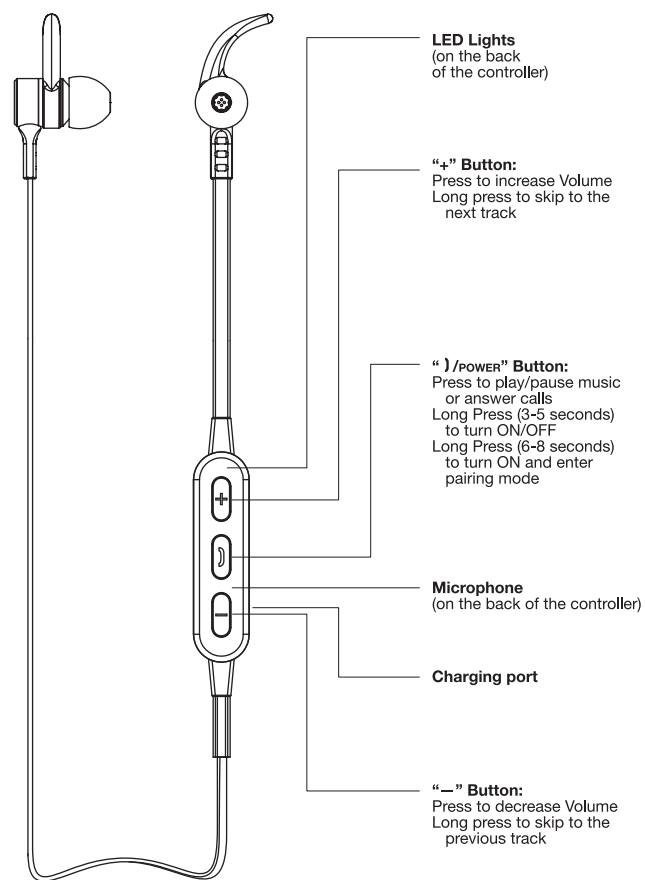
User's Manual for UZ-BTE85

Included:
BLADE Wireless Earbuds
3 Sizes of Silicone Earbuds Tips
Micro USB Charging Cable

IMPORTANT Please read before using this product

OUTSIDE

PRODUCT/CONTROLS DIAGRAM



CHARGE IT

- Plug the micro USB cable into the micro USB port on the side of the in-line remote and connect the other end of the cable to either a computer USB port or a USB-compatible charger.
- Solid red LED light will indicate when the earbuds are charging, even while they are turned off.
- When charging is complete, the LED light will turn off.
- Charging time is approximately 1.5 hours.

POWER ON

- Press & hold the power button on the BLADE earbuds for 3-4 seconds.
- The earbuds will power on, a blue LED light will flash, and will automatically reconnect to the last Bluetooth device they were connected to.
- If you haven't connected the earbuds to any device follow the steps below.

PAIR & CONNECT WITH A NEW DEVICE

- If your earbuds are OFF, press & hold the power button for 6-10 seconds to power on and enter pairing mode.
- If your earbuds are ON, press the power button once to enter the pairing mode.
- The LED light will quickly flash red & blue. Your earbuds are ready to be paired.
- On your Bluetooth-enabled device, navigate to the Bluetooth settings menu, turn on the Bluetooth feature and search for new devices.
- After a few seconds you will see "UZ-BTE85" listed.
- Tap this model to select it. The LED will begin to slowly blink blue, and the earbuds will emit a tone to indicate that it has been successfully paired with your device.

NOTE: You only need to pair your Bluetooth device with the BLADE earbuds once.

NOTE: If your device asks for a password to connect to the earbuds, enter "0000"

PLAY

- Connect your device to the BLADE earbuds via Bluetooth (see "Pair & Connect with a New Device").
- Open your favorite music app and press play.
- Control the track & volume from your device, or using the in-line controls on the BLADE earbuds. Press the "Power" button once to play/pause music & answer calls.
- Press the "+" or "-" button once raise/lower the volume on the earbuds. Press and hold to skip to the next/previous track. Note: Volume on your device and on the earbuds are controlled separately.
- All audio, including music, games, videos, and notifications will be routed through the BLADE earbuds.

POWER OFF

- Press and hold power button for 3-5 seconds.
- The earbuds and LED light will turn off.

INSIDE
