



Pairing With A Bluetooth Device



- : When play music (LINE IN/BT), press short to switch FM/BT. (switch to line in, if via AUX cable to audio device).
- : When play music, press short for last song, press long to turn down the volume
- 台: When play music, press short for next song, press long to turn up the volume.
- : When play music (LINE IN/BT), press short for "play/pause". under BT mode with mobile paired, press short to answer a call, press again to hand up. In FM mode, press short to search station automatically, press again to stop searching). Note:Under FM mode, put in the AUX cable to get better FM radio station.

Playing Music

While the unit is connected and paired to your device,navigate to the music app and select a song to begin playback. You can use either the playback controls on the app, or the controls on the speaker. Long press the previous/next buttons on the speaker to increase/decrease volume. When the speaker reaches max volume, the speaker will emit an audible beep tone. You can also use the play/pause button to answer and hang up phone calls.

AUX Mode

Insert a 3.5mm audio cable into the speaker's AUX port and the speaker will enter AUX mode to play back audio from an external wired source. You can also use the "M" button to switch the speaker from AUX to Bluetooth mode. When in Bluetooth mode, pressing the "M" button will repair the device.

<u>Charging</u>

Use the included micro-USB cable to charge the device through a standard USB charger. The LED will turn red when charging and turn off when charging is complete.

Note: If the speaker does not detect a connection to a device, the speaker will automatically shut down after 30 minutes to save power. To extend the service time, please turn the power switch to OFF position
