4.5 TRANSMITTER SPURIOUS RADIATED EMISSIONS

4.5.1 TEST DESCRIPTION

The test set-up was made in accordance to the general provisions of ANSI C63.10 in a typical installation configuration. 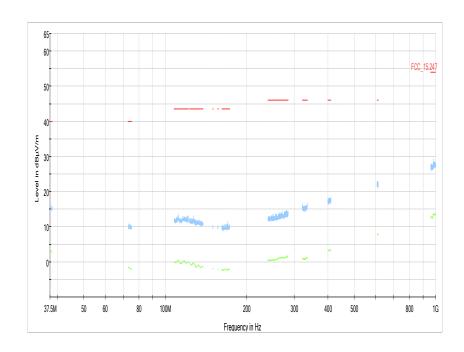

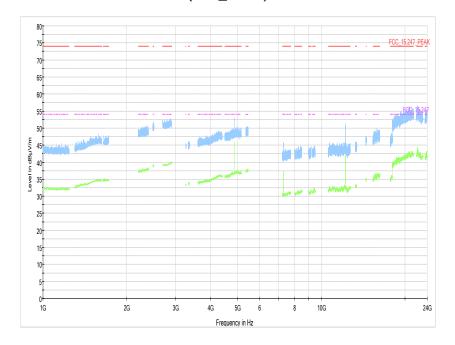

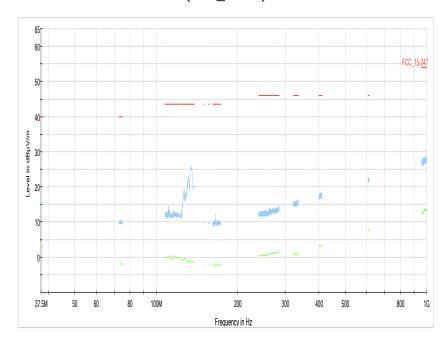




Radio Technology = Bluetooth LE, Operating Frequency = mid, Measurement range = 1 GHz - 26 GHz (S01_AD01)

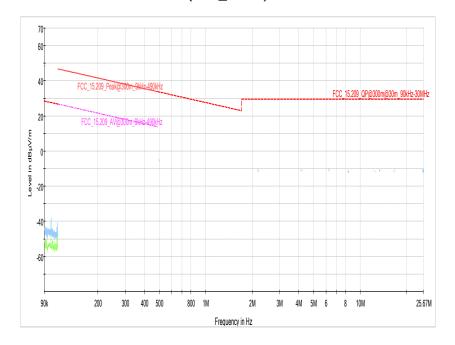


Radio Technology = Bluetooth LE, Operating Frequency = high, Measurement range = 30 MHz - 1 GHz (S01_AD01)

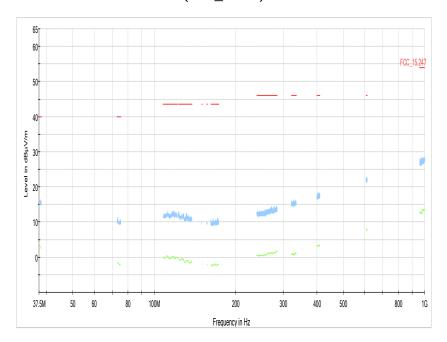




Radio Technology = Bluetooth LE, Operating Frequency = mid, Measurement range = 9 kHz - 30 MHz (S01_AD01)

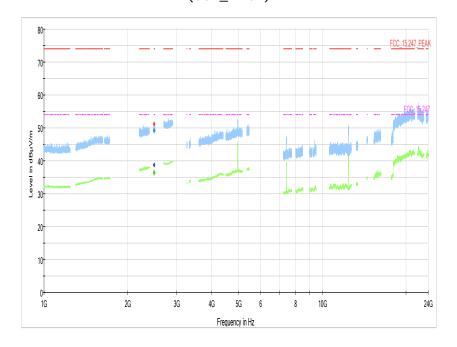


Radio Technology = Bluetooth LE, Operating Frequency = low, Measurement range = 30 MHz - 1 GHz (S01_AD01)

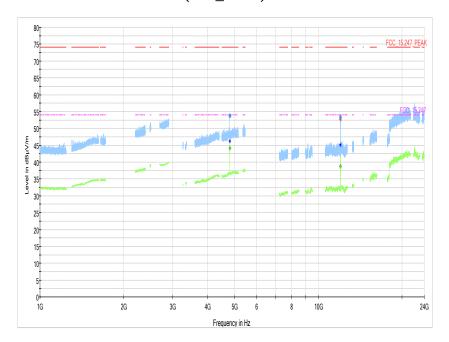




Radio Technology = Bluetooth LE, Operating Frequency = high, Measurement range = 1 GHz - 26 GHz (S01_AD01)

4.8.4 MEASUREMENT PLOT (SHOWING THE HIGHEST VALUE, "WORST CASE")



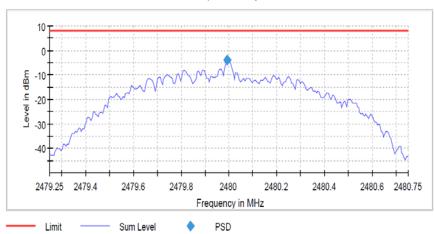

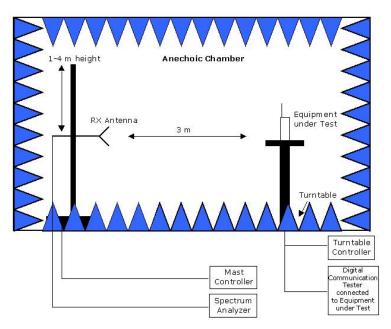

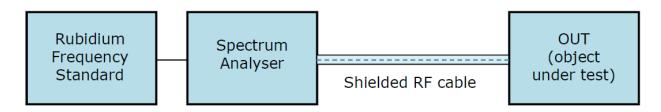
