

About the rechargeable Battery & Charging

Regarding the lithium rechargeable battery This Bluetooth Speaker has an internal, non-userreplaceable battery. For best results, the first time you use this Bluetooth Speaker, let it charge for about 2 ~ 3 hours or until the "Charge LED (2)" Indicator light switches off.

- To maintain the battery life and performance:
- Never fully deplete the battery

that the battery is charging.

•Charge the item at least every 3 months even when not using the item

To recharge the built-in battery: Connect the Bluetooth Speaker's "Micro USB socket (9)" with the Computer's USB through the USB cable. The "Charge LED (2)" Indicator will turn red, indicating

The "Charge LED (2)" Indicator will turn Off when the rechargeable battery is fully charged. Please disconnect the USB cable once the battery is full.

Switching on the device

- Press and hold the "(1)" button to switch On the device. A series of tones will sound from speaker. And the "Bluetooth LED (3)"indicator will blink blue rapidly.
- · Next activate the Bluetooth function in your mobile device the device will go into Bluetooth searching mode automatically.
- · Your mobile device should show "Laud Shower Cube" in the list, select it for pairing. Wait for a few seconds as the devices will connect with each other. In case you need to enter a code, enter 0000
- If pairing has been successful, a voice will announce from the speakers and the "Bluetooth LED (3)" indicator will start blinking each 3 ~ 4 seconds.
- · You can now select the song on your device that you want to play.
- · Press and hold the "(1)" button to turn Off the device when it is not in use.
- Note: the device will turn Off automatically in about 8 minutes if all Bluetooth connections are outside its reach

Disconnect from paired device

- · Press and hold the " (7)" button to switch to new "Searching / Pairing" mode, the paired device will disconnect
- You can choose "Disconnect" from Bluetooth paired devices list on your mobile device.
- In this case: the Bluetooth Speaker will turn back into "Searching / Pairing" mode in seconds, a series of tones will sound and the "Bluetooth LED (3)" indicator will start blinking in Blue.
- Now you can search for new devices.

Auto re-connect with paired device and New pairing

- Every time you turn On the Bluetooth speaker power: it will firstly searching for the mobile device, which has been paired previously Laud Shower Cube and still in record. The Bluetooth Speaker will re-connect this mobile device as priority if it is in Bluetooth searching device mode.
- If not found in some seconds, the Bluetooth Speaker then is turn into new pairing mode internally.
- Now you can process for new mobile device pair.

Bluetooth Music Playing Control Function

- While playing music, press " (7)" button to pause the music. To resume the music press it again.
- Press and hold the "(5)" button to increases the volume level Press and hold the " (4)" button to decrease the
- volume level. When maximum or minimum volume is reached, a
- series of tones will sound.
- Press the "(5)" button once to go to the next song.
 Press the "(4)" button once to go to previous song.

Hands Free Function

- · When there is an incoming call while listening to music you can pick up the call with the speaker
- The ringing sound will announce.
- The music will pause automatically.
- Press " (6)" button to pick up the call.
- Now you have speak using the hands free function on the Bluetooth speaker.
- Press " (6)" button again to hang up the call when
- The paused music will start to play automatically.
- Press and hold "(6)" button for 3 seconds to ignore the incoming call.
