## Operation

**Power on:** Press and hold down the power button till a blue light appears

**Power off:** Press and hold down the power button till a red light appears

**Pairing:** Press and hold down the power button 6~8 seconds till red and blue light flashing

**Volume adjust:** Press the volume + to increase volume or Volume - to decrease the volume

**Music track choose:** Press and hold Volume - to select previous track, and Volume + to select the next track.

**Pause/play:** When the bluetooth headset is connected with mobile phone, press the power button once to play music, press power button quickly to pause the music.

**Answering/ending the call:** Press the power button once to answering or end the call

**Reject calling:** Press the power button 1 seconds

## LED instruction

**Charging:** Red LED when charging, after full charge, blue LED

**Paired:** Blue Led flashing slow

**Pairing:** Red and blue LED flashing alternate
