

TROUBLESHOOTING

Turbo is powered on, but doesn't respond to remote control input. Check the channel switch on both your Turbo and your remote controller. They both need to be on the same channel, either Channel 1, or Channel 2. If it still doesn't have any response you can try changing the batteries in the remote.

Turbo restarts OR shuts down while performing a task/command. Turbo's batteries are flat, replace with fresh batteries.

Turbo is not responding to Voice Commands.

- Always say "Yo?" first when you say a command.
- If Turbo cannot understand the command he will say "Say that again" in which case you will need to start again by saying "Turbo" (Refer to "Voice Command" section in the instructions page).
- Avoid using Voice Command in a noisy environment and be within 3 feet / 1m of Turbo.
- Always face Turbo when speaking.
- Ensure Turbo is the right way up as the microphone is located on top of his head.
- Turbo's batteries might be flat, replace with fresh batteries.

Audio quality of the recording's playback is poor or unclear/inaudible.

- When recording a message, ensure to be within 3 feet / 1m of Turbo.
- Avoid recording in a noisy environment.
- Always record Turbo in the same environment.
- Ensure Turbo is the right way up as the microphone is located on top of his head.
- Ensure the SFX/Playback Selector is switched to Playback mode before pressing SFX / Playback button.

The remote control is unreliable when 2 Turbos are in the same area. Ensure that the 2 Turbos are using different radio control channels. To avoid radio control interference, there can be no more than 2 active Turbos in the same environment.

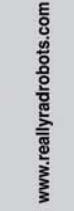

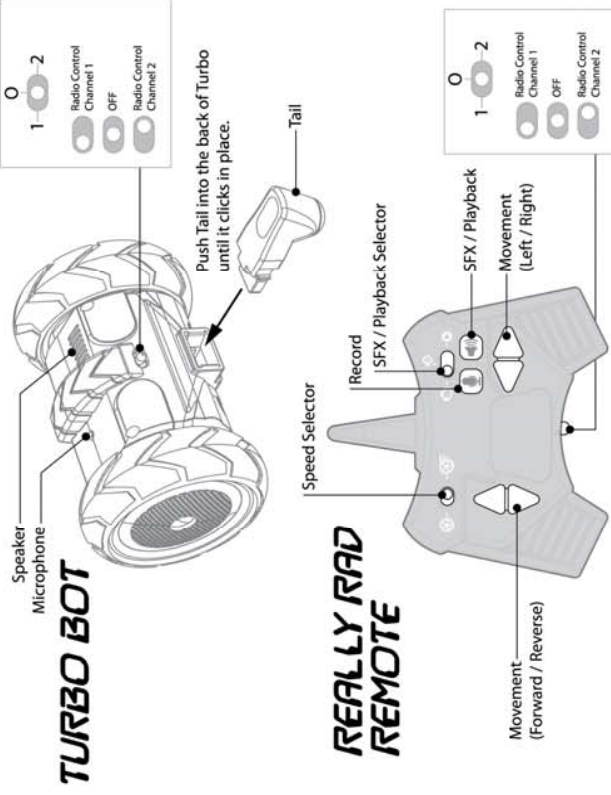

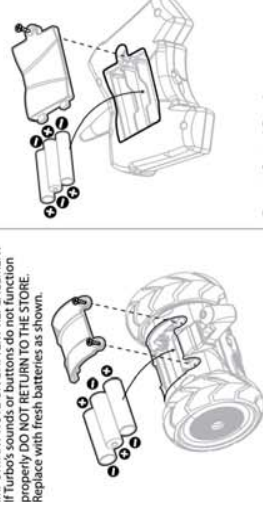

BATTERIES

IMPORTANT NOTE ON BATTERY REPLACEMENT: Rechargeable batteries must be removed from the toy before being charged. Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision. Different types of batteries or new and used batteries are not to be recharged together. Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used. Batteries should be replaced by an adult. Batteries are to be removed with the correct polarity. Exhausted batteries are to be removed from product. The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited. Batteries are to be removed from the product before long term storage. Batteries should be recycled or disposed of as per state and local guidelines. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.



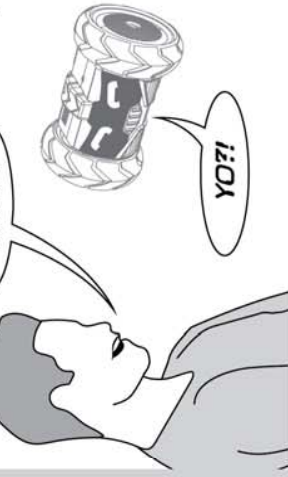

VOICE COMMAND

Only activate Voice Command when Turbo is stationary and not playing any sound effects.



Step 1.

Always start by calling his name "Turbo".

TIP: Ensure to speak loud and clear and avoid noisy environments.

Wait until Turbo responds with "YO?!" before stating a command.

TIP: If Turbo did not respond, say his name again.

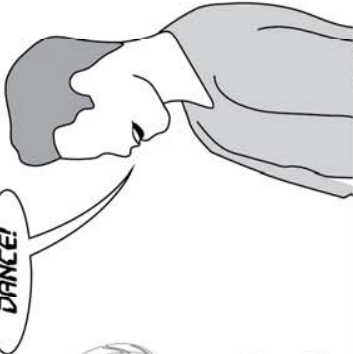
Step 2.

Say one of the following 4 commands:

- "DANCE"
- "SPIN"
- "JOKE"
- "EXPLORE"

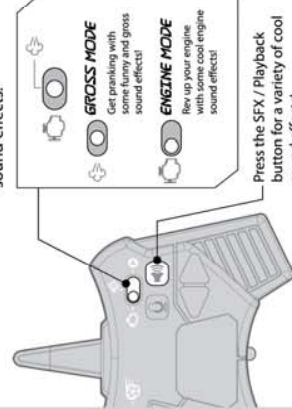
TIP:

- If Turbo does not respond, say the command again.
- If Turbo says "Say that again", you will have to start from Step 1 (repeating his name "turbo").
- Ensure to face Turbo and speak loud and clear.
- The mischievous Turbo may not always follow your command, he may sometimes choose to perform a different act!



SFX

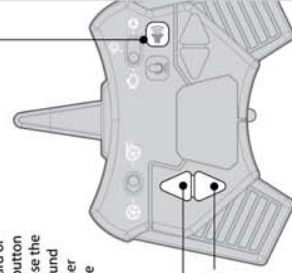
Use the SFX Selector to select desired sound effects.



SFX VOLUME ADJUSTMENT

Hold down the SFX / Playback button for 4 seconds to enter the volume setting mode. Then press the Forward or Reverse Movement button to increase or decrease the volume of Turbo's sound effects. Press any other button to exit volume setting mode.

- ▲ Volume up
- ▼ Volume down



FAQ

What is the remote control range?

This depends on the environment. Generally Turbo can be controlled within a 80 feet / 25m range. For best performance avoid operating near a WiFi router and avoid having brick walls in between the remote controller and Turbo.

How fast can Turbo travel?

This depends on the surface Turbo is travelling on. On a flat but non slippery surface Turbo can reach a top speed of 4mph / 6kph in Turbo mode.

What surfaces can Turbo travel on?

Turbo works well on flat surfaces such as ceramic or wooden floor tiles, flat concrete floor etc. It can travel on short carpets or slightly bumpy surfaces but speed will be reduced. Turbo cannot handle sand or gravel surfaces.

Can multiple Turbos work in the same area?

Maximum of 2 Turbos can work in close proximity but they have to be operating on different radio channels. To avoid radio control interference, there can be no more than 2 active Turbos in the same environment.

How far should I stand from Turbo for it register Voice Commands?

Voice command works best if user is within 3 feet / 1m from Turbo. Ensure to face Turbo and speak loud and clear.

What is the battery life of Turbo?

Battery life depends on your driving style and how frequently "Turbo speed" is used. If Turbo starts to restart often or shuts down unexpectedly, replace with fresh batteries.
