

Instructions:

- 1. Wireless Charging Mobile phones and other electronic devices:
- · Connect the provided Type-C cable to the Type-C input port on the wireless charging side of the desk organizer, then connect the USB end of the cable to a power source LED indicator will flash red for 2 seconds then stay red when wireless charging standby.
- Place the wireless charging supported device on the wireless charging surface(7). using the MagClick® function, indicator will glow blue in charging.
- If the device does not support MagClick®:
- Using the magnetic phone stand(8) adjust the device to the required height, phone will begin to charge automatically once placed in the correct location.
- Once fully charged remove the device.
- ** Note: When wireless charging, if the LED indicator flashes blue the device is either NOT a wireless charging device or there is an object between the device and charging surface interfering with the charging. process.


- WARNING-When using this product, basic precautions should always be followed:
