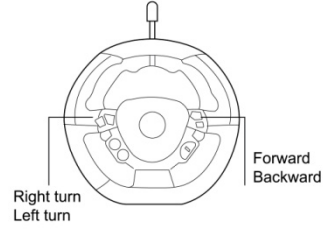
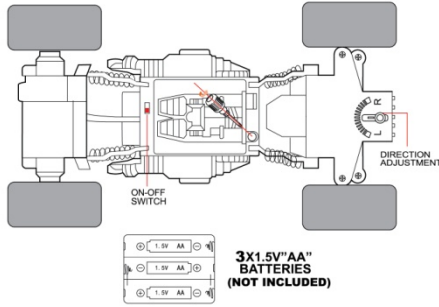


Caution for using batteries:

- While placing batteries, please insert them as per the polarities.
- Never mix new and old batteries.
- Don't charge the non-rechargeable batteries.
- Please don't mix alkaline, carbonic or rechargeable batteries.
- When the car is not used, batteries must be taken out.
- Please check its wires, plug, outer cover and other parts regularly.
- If any of them is damaged, please stop using and repair it.

To customers:

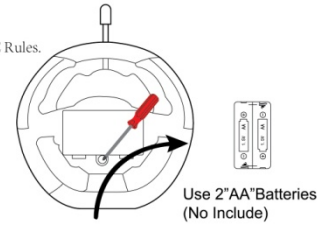
1. When using the remote control car indoors, please take care not to cause any damage of the furniture or glasses.
2. In case of any danger, don't play in the house or crowd. Please play it in safe places outdoors.
3. When playing it outdoors, if there is thunder, stop playing it at once.
4. To avoid the distraction of the crowd, please don't play it in places with water or sand.
5. Never hit the others (especially if it's broken, its sharp part may cause injury).
6. Don't step the wire of its body, because it may lose some functions when the wire is broken.
7. When the wheels are running, never touch them with hands to avoid injury. The attention is to manage hair or clothes.
8. Never run the remote control car directly against.
9. Never leave about or crash the remote control car.
10. Please keep the remote control car away from fire or heat.
11. This car is equipped with complicated circuits and electronic parts. Please don't disassemble it with the usual tools.
12. When the car stops, don't or fly out of control, please replace it with new batteries.
