
AUDIO QUICK START GUIDE

INLINE MICROPHONE



REMOTE BUTTON These earbuds with 3-button & mic are compatible with all smartphones, Apple devices (iPod, iPhone, iPad), and Samsung/Android mobile devices.

Function review

- To answer/end call, press the ${\textstyle \binom{c}{2}}$ button once to answer and press again to end the call
- To play/pause music, press the (button once
- To skip to the next song, press
 button once
- To go to the previous song,press ⊨button once
- To decline an incoming call, hold down the $\ensuremath{\mathfrak{C}}$ button for about two seconds
- To raise volume, hold and press the ⊕ button
- To lower volume, hold and press the □ button
- To redial last call , double click the 🕻 button

PAIRING

- 1. Make sure your BPM earbuds are fully charged.
- 2. Make sure your BPM earbuds are turned off by pressing & holding the call button until the light turns off.
- 3. Go to "Bluetooth" Settings on your device (Phone, Tablet, Etc..).
- 4. Turn the Bluetooth On.
- 5. Turn your earbuds into pair mode by pressing and holding the & button on your earbuds until the LED light starts flashing Blue and Red.
- 6. Select '2BMEB0218' on the list of available devices.
- 7. You are now connected!

(Trouble shooting tip: if the Bluetooth pairing does not sync, turn off the Bluetooth on your device as well as turn off the headphones, then turn on the device's Bluetooth followed by the headphones and follow the instructions normally)

CHARGING THE EARBUDS

The earbuds come with a built-in rechargeable battery. Before using it for the first time, we recommend you charge the battery fully. Only use the supplied USB cable to charge the earbuds. Connect the USB cable to a computer or any USB charger, and connect the opposite end to your earbuds. The red LED light will illuminate while the earphones are charging. A full charge of the battery takes around 1.5 hours. When the battery is fully charged, the LED light will turn off. Disconnect the headset at this point. The headset will then be ready for use. When using your earphones with an iPhone, the top right corner will indicate your ear bud's battery life.
